### Incidents

**Reckless Handling of a Firearm-** On June 21 at 11:03PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 11900 block of Cotton Mill Dr in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a self-inflicted shooting. The investigation revealed a 31-year-old man was cleaning his firearm when the firearm discharged, striking the man in the hand and leg. Arriving officers rendered life-saving aid, and the man was transported to an area hospital for treatment. No additional injuries or damage to property were reported.

**Vandalism-** On June 20, officers responded to the Home Depot, located at 15450 John Marshall Hwy in Haymarket (20169) to investigate a vandalism that was reported to have occurred at 3:30AM that morning. The investigation revealed two unknown men spray painted derogatory slurs and other lettering on multiple pallets and on the ground in the parking lot, before leaving the area on foot. No additional markings were located.

## Arrests

**Malicious Wounding on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]-** On June 18, detectives responded to the BP service station, located at 7206 Centreville Rd in Manassas (20111) to assist the Fairfax County Police Department [FCPD] with apprehending a known wanted individual. During the investigation, detectives located the wanted individual, identified as the accused at the service station. While attempting to take the accused into custody, the accused assaulted an FCPD officer, before fleeing on foot. Officers gave chase and an FCPD officer deployed an electronic restraining device, before taking the accused into custody. The FCPD officer and the accused both sustained injuries and were transported to an area hospital for treatment. Following the investigation, detectives obtained arrest warrants and the accused, identified as Brandon Troy **COLLINS**, was taken into custody by Fairfax County Police.

As an officer was conducting a search of the accused, he became aggressive and assaulted two officers, before being secured. No injuries were reported by the officers. During the investigation, officers detained one of the involved parties, identified as the accused. While placing the accused in the police cruiser, she became aggressive and bit an officer. During the encounter, the accused continued to be aggressive and attempted to bite another officer before being secured. Minor injuries were sustained by the officer.
