**Strong-Armed Robbery \*UPDATE-** On June 11, officers obtained charges for a suspect sought in connection with a robbery that was reported to have occurred at the Nordstrom Rack located at 2700 Potomac Mills Cir in Woodbridge (22192) on May 8. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Nicholas James **CARROLL**, was taken into custody by Prince William County Sheriff's Office.

**Strong-Armed Robbery [Previously Released]-** On May 8, officers responded to Nordstrom Rack located at 2700 Potomac Mills Cir in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a robbery that reportedly took place at approximately 2:53PM. The investigation revealed an unknown man entered the store and took merchandise. During the encounter, the suspect assaulted an employee, before leaving the area on foot. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a white male, aged 25-35 years, wearing an orange beanie, blue hoodie, gray shorts, and black and white sneakers.

## Incidents

**Attempted Assault with a Caustic Substance-** On June 21 at 11:43AM, officers responded to the 7-Eleven located at 8375 Sudley Rd in Manassas (20109) to investigate an assault. The investigation revealed the victim, a 40-year-old man, was sitting in his parked vehicle with a family member when he was approached by an unknown man. A verbal altercation ensued and during the encounter, the suspect attempted to spray the victim with a chemical irritant, before leaving the area on foot. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male in his 30's, bald, wearing a black hat, black t-shirt with multi-colored writing and light-colored cargo shorts.

**Residential Burglary-** On June 22, officers responded to a residence located in the 13100 block of Sapphire Ridge Pl in Bristow (20136) to investigate a robbery that was reported to have occurred between June 20 at 4:40PM and June 22 at 6:30PM. The investigation revealed during that timeframe, the residence was entered and a 3D printer, air compressor and other items were reported stolen. No damage to property was reported and no suspect description was available.
