Incidents

Sexual Assault Investigation - On June 24, officers responded to investigate a sexual assault that was reported to have occurred in the area of Thenia Pl in Woodbridge (22192) on June 22 at approximately 1:30PM. The investigation revealed the victim, a 22-year-old woman, was walking in the 13300 block of Occoquan Rd when she was approached by an unknown man and offered a ride. During the encounter, the suspect parked the vehicle in an unfamiliar area and sexually assaulted the victim, before allowing her to exit the vehicle. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male, aged 50-53 years old, with short, dark hair, wearing a grey t-shirt and blue jeans, last seen driving a grey, 4-door sedan.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On June 24, officers responded to a residence located in the 13800 block of Botts Ave in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a report of shots fired that occurred at 1:10PM that afternoon. The investigation revealed a verbal altercation ensued after an individual entering a vehicle made a hand gesture towards another driver in a red 4-door sedan, identified as the suspect. During the encounter, the suspect fired three gunshots into the ground as the individual drove away from the area. No injuries or property damage were reported. Shell casings were located in the area. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male with a beard and black hair, wearing a dark-blue Yankees hat, and a dark colored shirt.

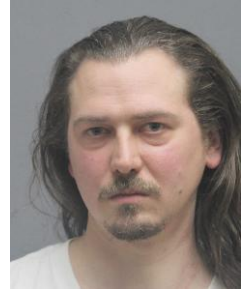

Arrests

Attempted Malicious Wounding- On June 24 at 8:21PM, officers responded to Brothers Encore, located at 5135 Waterway Dr in Dumfries (22025) to investigate a report of a disorderly individual with a weapon. The investigation revealed the victim, an employee of the restaurant, was involved in a verbal altercation with an intoxicated patron, later identified as the accused. During the encounter, the accused assaulted and attempted to stab the victim with a knife. The accused was restrained by the victim and Good Samaritans until officers arrived and detained him. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as David Andrew **FIES**, was arrested.
