

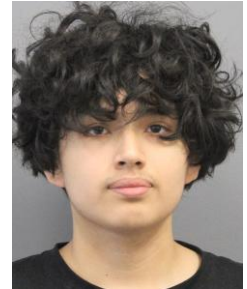


## DAILY INCIDENT REPORT

### Updates

**Murder Investigation \*ARRESTS** – Prince William County detectives have charged two individuals in connection to the shooting death of an 18-year-old Manassas man that occurred in the area of Peppertree Ln and Pebble Ln in Manassas (20111) on June 15. Following the investigation, detectives obtained charges and both individuals, identified as Markiss Alexander **MEDRANO** and a **16-year-old male juvenile**, were arrested. The investigation continues.

Charged with **2<sup>nd</sup> degree murder** and **use of a firearm in commission of a felony**

**Homicide Investigation [Previously Released]**- On June 15 at 9:57PM, officers responded to the area of Old Centreville Rd and Parkland St in Manassas (20111) to investigate a report of shots fired. During the initial investigation, officers determined a shooting occurred in the nearby Bull Run Mobile Home Community, in the area of Peppertree Ln and Pebble Ln. The investigation revealed the victim, an 18-year-old man, was in the area when he was shot in the upper body. Following the encounter, the victim attempted to leave the area and collapsed in the backyard of a nearby residence on Parrish Ln. Officers located the victim, attempted life-saving measures and ultimately, the victim was pronounced dead on scene. The suspects left the area and were not immediately located. Additionally, during the investigation a residence located in the 7400 block of Peppertree Ln was found to be struck by gunfire. **Preliminarily, this incident does not appear to be random. Detectives are asking anyone with any information, or anyone who may have witnessed the incident, to contact police.** Additional information will be released when available. The investigation continues.

## Incidents

**Homicide Investigation-** On June 25 at 8:47PM, officers responded to the 7900 block of Community Dr in Manassas (20109) to investigate what was initially reported as a crash. Arriving officers quickly located a vehicle that had crashed into an unoccupied, parked car. As officers approached the vehicle they located the victim, an 18-year-old man, in the driver's seat of the vehicle with a gunshot wound to the upper body. The man was pronounced dead on scene. The suspects left the area and were not immediately located. **Preliminarily, this incident does not appear to be random. Detectives are asking anyone with any information, or anyone who may have witnessed the incident, to contact police.** Additional information will be released when available. The investigation continues.

## Arrests

**Brandishing | Possession of a Weapon on School Property-** On June 24, officers responded to River Oaks Elementary School located at 16950 McGuffeys Trl in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a brandishing that reportedly occurred at 8:44AM that morning. The investigation revealed a man, later identified as the accused, was walking his dog on school property when he was approached by a school security officer (SSO) and informed animals were not allowed on the property. During the encounter, the accused threatened the SSO and displayed a firearm before leaving the area. No injuries were reported and no shots were fired. The next day, officers located the accused, who had initially fled from officers as they attempted to detain him. The accused was located a short time later and taken into custody. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Dewayne Andrew **WILLIAMS**, was arrested.

**Peeping into a Dwelling-** On June 25 at 11:19PM, officers responded to the 1400 block of Bayside Ave in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a report of a peeping tom. The investigation revealed a security guard observed an unknown man, later identified as the accused, peeping into the window of the victim, a 17-year-old female juvenile. Arriving officers detained the accused and found him to be in an intoxicated state. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Rene Alfredo **MUSUN MELENDEZ**, was arrested.



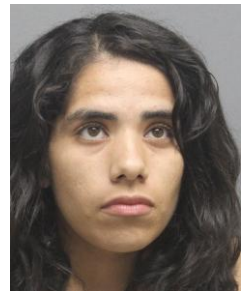

The investigation revealed a 23-year-old woman, later identified as the accused, was intoxicated and walking in the roadway. At one point, the woman removed her shirt and exposed herself. Following the investigation the accused, identified as Gabriela Michelle **AGUILAR**, was arrested.
