### Incidents

**Sexual Assault Investigation-** On June 26, officers responded to investigate a sexual assault that was reported to have occurred in the 14900 block of Richmond Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) at approximately 3:50PM that afternoon. The investigation revealed the victim, a 38-year-old woman, was walking to her car when she was approached by an unknown man. The suspect told the victim she had an insect on her back and asked if he could assist her. The suspect then inappropriately touched the victim, before leaving the area. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a black male, heavy set, with bushy, black hair and a goatee, wearing a navy-blue jacket, white t-shirt, black pants and light-colored shoes.

**Brandishing-** On June 27, officers responded to investigate a road rage incident that was reported to have occurred in the area of Hillendale Dr and Hendricks Dr in Woodbridge (22193) at 5:33PM that evening. The investigation revealed the victims, a 25-year-old man and 21-year-old woman, were driving on Prince William Pkwy when a red Ford Escape swerved into their lane. During the encounter, the driver of the vehicle was verbally aggressive and followed the victims to the above area. The suspect then brandished a firearm at the victims, before leaving the area in the vehicle. No injuries were reported and no shots were fired. The suspect was described as a black male, early 20's, with dreadlocks, wearing a dark-colored shirt and beanie hat.

## Arrests

**Reckless Handling of a Firearm-** On June 27, officers responded to a residence located in the 2900 block of Shumard Oak Dr in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a self-inflicted shooting that was reported to have occurred on June 24 at approximately 11:00PM. The investigation revealed the homeowner, later identified as the accused, was handling a firearm when the firearm discharged, striking the accused in the hand. The accused was transported to an area hospital that night for treatment. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Kevym Leo **TRUONG**, was arrested.
