Incidents

Death Investigation- On June 29 at 8:07AM, officers responded to Sam's Car Wash, located at 8129 Sudley Rd in Manassas (20109) to investigate a report of an unconscious individual. The investigation revealed the individual, identified as a 62-year-old man, was located unconscious in one of the car wash bays. The man is believed to have entered the business sometime overnight and was pronounced dead on scene. Preliminarily, there were no signs of foul play or threat to the community concerning the death. More information regarding the investigation will be released if deemed necessary.

Arrests

Malicious Wounding | Strong-Armed Robbery- On June 29 officers responded to investigate a stabbing that was reported to have occurred in the 2000 block of Daniel Stuart Sq in Woodbridge (22191) at 12:30AM that morning. The investigation revealed the victim, a 27- year-old man, and a female friend initially met up with an acquaintance, later identified as the accused, in the 14500 block of Richmond Hwy. During the encounter, the accused grabbed an undisclosed amount of money from the woman's hand and fled the area on foot. The victim followed the accused to a nearby parking lot where the accused produced a knife and stabbed the victim in the upper body. The victim sustained non-life-threatening injuries and was transported to an area hospital for treatment. Officers located the accused a short time later and detained him. During a search of the accused, an illicit substance was found on his person. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Jhonny Bladimir **MARTINEZ VALDEZ**, was arrested.

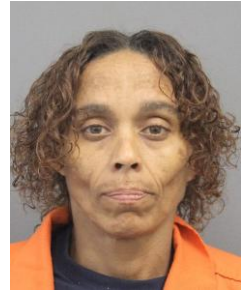

Malicious Wounding by Caustic Substance- On June 29 at 3:30AM, officers responded to the intersection of Richmond Hwy and Featherstone Rd in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an assault. The investigation revealed the victim, a 50-year-old man, was in the area when he was approached by an unknown woman, later identified as the accused. During the encounter, the accused stated the victim stole her bicycle and threw a cup of bleach at him, before leaving the area. The victim sustained minor injuries and was treated on scene by medics. The accused was located by officers a short time later and detained. During a search of the accused, an illicit substance was found on her person. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Talia Marie **NESEMEIER**, was arrested.
