POLICY INFORMATION**

The current **Bluebird Policy** manual is online at www.pwcva.gov/departments/area-agency-aging/bluebird-tours. **It is your responsibility to make yourself aware of important information concerning your Bluebird experience.**

Payment Policy

A reservation must be confirmed **immediately** with a **check, money order, or credit card**. In the amount of **\$5 for a one-day tour and \$10 for an overnight tour to hold your space. The balance will be charged up to 30 days before the trip. When making a payment, request a receipt by providing an active email address. Quality Tours requires deposits for certain trips at the time of booking and are noted in that trip's description. The deposit would be refundable if the trip does not run.**

Refunds and Cancellations

There is a **"No Refund"** policy in place unless and if, when you cancel there is a standby list and from it, we can find a replacement. If you need to cancel your reservation, please call Quality Tours and speak to one of our agents handling the Bluebird Tour Program. All cancellations are subject to an administration fee of \$5.00 for one-day trips and \$10.00 for overnight trips. **A refund will only be given if there is someone on the "standby list" to take your space.** Trip cancellation insurance is available only for overnight tours and it is highly suggested.

Inclement Weather

If Prince William County Schools are closed due to inclement weather, Quality Tours and the Area Agency on Aging will review any scheduled day or overnight trips during the closure. Once a decision has been made as to whether the trip will continue as scheduled or be cancelled, considering travel conditions and venue closures, the RIDE line will be updated immediately. Quality Tours will notify riders of the cancellation at least two hours before the first pick-up.

Schedule and Trip Information

All tours may take place on a Quality Tour Transport motor coach. Schedules for the Bluebird trips can be printed from the web page located at: www.pwcva.gov/departments/area-agency-aging/bluebird-tours. You will be added to the maintained address book. NOTE: Call 703-792-7433 (RIDE) to check if the current trip is operating as scheduled.

Guidelines for Tipping

The suggested gratuity for a driver is \$4 - \$5 per day. The gratuity for sightseeing guides is included in the cost of tour. If a meal is included in a tour, all taxes and gratuities have already been included in the tour cost (excluding alcoholic beverages). Tour escorts may be tipped upon departing the bus at the end of the trip, if you care to.

Trip Insurance

TRIP CANCELLATION INSURANCE IS AVAILABLE ONLY ON OVERNIGHT TOURS AND IS NOT INCLUDED in the price of the overnight trips. Insurance is available to everyone through **Travelguard.com**. **Rates are based on the cost of the tour and your age.** The insurance provides trip cancellation coverage, trip interruption coverage, baggage up to \$500, emergency accident/sickness medical expenses up to \$2,500, and emergency fees. **Contact Dee Creek at (703) 339-0333 for further information, or go online to travelguard.com**

Seating Policy for One Day Trips

Passengers boarding in Manassas sit on the Driver's side of the bus. Passengers boarding in Woodbridge sit on the Door side of the bus.

Departure Points

Plan to arrive at least **15 minutes before trip** departure time.

One Day Tours

Manassas at Wal-Mart is located at 9401 Liberia Avenue. We load in the parking lot on your right close to Wawa. No parking overnight.

Woodbridge at Featherstone Shopping Center is located at 14527 Richmond Highway. We load in the rear of McDonald's. No parking overnight.

Overnight Tours

Manassas at the public parking lot next door to the Manassas Sr. Center located at 9320 Mosby Street, Manassas, VA 20110.

Woodbridge at the A. J. Ferlazzo Building located at 15941 Donald Curtis Drive, Woodbridge, VA 22191. For this pickup point you will receive a parking permit in with your baggage tags and itinerary.

Return Times

The bus driver and/or escort will make the decision as to which location will be dropped off first. It will be based on factors that affect driving.

Note: All return times are approximate. The driver will provide a more exact time on the return day.

Alcohol

No consumption of alcohol is permitted on the bus.

Note

The trip escort is permitted to make changes as deemed necessary to trip itineraries while on the road.

RESERVATIONS

Reservations commence immediately on the date the new schedule is up on the following internet sites: www.pwcva.gov/department/area-agency-aging/bluebird-tours- or BB4information@aol.com or www.qualitytour.com or www.dctrails.com or **printed copies** of the program distributed to the two senior centers as well as at the **McCoart Building** or **Ferlazzo Building** or your **local libraries**. Beginning then, reservations are accepted by **telephone only** at (703) 339-0333 beginning at 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Monday-Friday. Reservations can be made for up to four people for multiple tours per phone call. One-day **tours** will require twenty-five participants if the trip is within our local area and thirty participants if the trip is outside our local area. Overnight trips will require thirty participants. **Note: At the time of reservation any special accommodations, including but not limited to seating and dietary restrictions, should be mentioned.**

Note: Two weeks after the new brochure has been distributed any remaining space will be opened to residents over 18 years of age and individuals or groups from Prince William County or surrounding counties. Installment payments may be arranged for any tour with the reservationist at the time of booking. For single or multiple tour reservations, an individual check or money order is required for each trip and made payable to Quality Tour Transport, Inc. and mailed to:

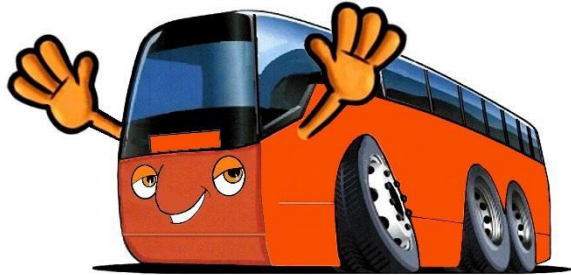

New Orleans is renowned for its distinctive music, Creole cuisine, unique dialects, and its annual celebrations and festivals, most notably Mardi Gras. The historic heart of the city is the French Quarter, known for its French and Spanish Creole architecture, along with vibrant nightlife on Bourbon Street. The city has been described as the "most lively" in the United States. This tour will include 5 full breakfasts, 1 lunch, and 4 dinners. We will depart from Woodbridge at 6:00 AM and from Manassas at 6:45 AM.

Day 1, September 22:

As we begin our journey south, Chattanooga, TN, is the first stop on our exciting New Orleans adventure. As you travel through the rolling hills of Virginia and into the scenic landscapes of the Appalachian region, enjoy the changing views of mountain ridges, charming small towns, and stretches of open countryside. Along the way, you'll have time to relax on the motorcoach, share conversation with fellow travelers, and anticipate the days ahead. By evening, you'll arrive in Chattanooga, a vibrant river city nestled against the foothills of the Appalachian Mountains, where you'll settle in for an overnight stay before continuing toward New Orleans. Dinner is included at a Cracker Barrel (\$25 Gift Card).

Day 2, September 23:

After a buffet breakfast at the hotel, we have an early departure for New Orleans. Rest stops and lunch stop will be made before we check into our French Quarter Hotel, The Wyndham, just steps away from the French Quarter. **Tonight, we learn about Cajun/Creole cooking as our chef prepares in front of us an authentic New Orleans-style dinner at the New Orleans School of Cooking! Watch, learn & eat!**

Day 3, September 24:

Breakfast this morning (every morning while here) will be at Mr. Ed's Southern Creole Kitchen.

Sit back and relax in comfort on your motorcoach as you enjoy a narrated driving tour through historic New Orleans. Pass Jackson Square, the French Market, and Congo Square. See Basin Street and hear about Storyville, the infamous red-light district of New Orleans, where Dixieland Jazz got its start. Travel down Bayou St. John, where the original plantation homes remain today. Walk through St. Louis III, one the New Orleans' famous cemeteries, and hear the story of the unique above-ground burial. Marvel as you drive under magnificent, 100-year-old oak trees in City Park. Coffee & beignets await you! Drive along Lake Pontchartrain, the 4th largest lake in the United States, and hear

about how New Orleans is built below sea level. Travel through the University section, uptown New Orleans, and down St. Charles Avenue, the avenue of streetcars, millionaires, and churches. See Millionaires Row, a replica of Tara from "Gone With the Wind", and many other magnificent mansions of the Avenue. Free time for shopping and lunch on your own at Riverwalk. A stop at Mardi Gras World for a tour and a mask-making class. **Dinner this evening will be aboard the steamboat Creole Queen on the Mississippi River with the Sullivan Dabney Jazz Band and a lavish Creole Buffet in the elegantly appointed dining room.**

Day 4, September 25:

After breakfast at Mr. Ed's Southern Creole Kitchen, we head out to tour the Historic Oak Alley Plantation near New Orleans. The Oak Alley Plantation, built in 1837, is a historic antebellum plantation located on the Mississippi River. The design is Greek Revival with a freestanding colonnade of 28 Doric columns. Enjoy a guided Tour of the Big House and self-guided walking tour of the grounds.

Private Guided Cajun Pride Swamp Tour

For many years, people have traveled extensively to locate a unique and exciting adventure exploring Louisiana's back country with its meandering bayous and swamps that you can only experience here - the historical Manchac Swamp.

The Battle of Gettysburg was a turning point in the Civil War, the Union victory that ended General Robert E. Lee's second and most ambitious invasion of the North. Often referred to as the "High Water Mark of the Rebellion", Gettysburg was the Civil War's bloodiest battle and was also the inspiration for President Abraham Lincoln's immortal "Gettysburg Address". Eisenhower National Historic Site preserves the farm of General and 34th President Dwight D. Eisenhower. Adjacent to the Gettysburg battlefield, the farm served the president and first lady as a weekend retreat and as a meeting place for world leaders. With its peaceful setting and view of South Mountain, it was a respite from Washington, DC, and a backdrop for efforts to reduce Cold War tensions. We will enjoy lunch at historic Dobbin House Tavern. We depart Woodbridge at 6:15 AM and Manassas at 7:00 AM. The return time is 7:00 PM

TOUR
Rutland & Bennington, VT
Cost: \$1259 pp Single \$959 pp**

Traveling to Vermont for the fall foliage is a bucket-list experience. Because 70% of the state is forested, you're almost guaranteed a spectacular show. Vermont is often called the "Fall Capital of the Country," which is why we chose the peak time to travel there to see the color show. We will depart Manassas at 6:00 AM and Woodbridge at 6:45 AM.

Day 1, October 6:

Today we depart on our deluxe motorcoach for a scenic drive to Rutland, Vermont. Here we have a lodge for the next 3 nights at the Comfort Inn, 19 Allen St., Rutland, Vermont. Dinner is at the nearby Victorian Inn, a beautiful 1877 mansion.

Dinner choices are: roast pork, sautéed chicken, or vegetarian lasagna.

Day 2, October 7:

This morning, after a full buffet at your hotel, we begin our tour of the Green Mountain state with a 90-minute buffet luncheon cruise on Lake Champlain, named in 1609 for the French explorer Samuel Champlain. Next, it's onto the Shelburne Museum, one of the nation's foremost museums of Americana. Yes, there is something for everyone here: colonial and Victorian homes, paintings, quilts, horse-drawn carriages, and toys. Even a restored private rail car, the nation's oldest side wheel steamer, and a circus exhibit with an antique carousel. Tonight, you have a treat in store for you with another evening of fine dining with a scrumptious buffet at the Waybury Inn in Middlebury. This 1910 stagecoach stop has become famous as the Vermont Inn used for the 1982 to 1900 TV series "Newhart."

Day 3, October 7:

After another full breakfast buffet, we head south to one of the state's most popular stops: The Vermont Country Store in the town of Weston. Next, it's onto Manchester, founded in 1761 and named after the town of Manchester, England. Here you will tour Hildene, the 1905 Georgian-style home of President Abraham Lincoln's son Robert Todd Lincoln. Built on 412 acres, this spectacular estate has original Lincoln family furnishings. The highlight of the tour will be seeing Mrs. Lincoln's 1000 Pipe Aeolian organ with its original organ rolls, which can still be played. Next, it's time for lunch and shopping on your own in Bennington, Vermont's first chartered town (1749). The next stop will be the Bennington Museum, which houses the largest collection of original Grandma Moses paintings in the world. This celebrated artist only lived a few miles west of this location and did not begin painting until she was 80 years old! We will end our touring day at the site where the Battle of Bennington took place on August 16, 1777, which led to the turning point of the Revolutionary War at Saratoga.

Tonight's dinner is at the nearby Public House, known for its superb cuisine. Choices are: Roast Turkey with Stuffing, baked Cod of pasta primavera.

Day 4, October 9:

This morning, after a full breakfast buffet at the hotel, we depart for home, making all the necessary comfort stops along the way.
