Updates

Murder Investigation *ARREST- Prince William County detectives have charged a man in connection to the shooting death of an 18-year-old Bristow man that occurred in the 7900 block of Community Dr in Manassas (20109) on June 25. On July 2, Prince William County detectives, with the assistance of the U.S. Marshal's Task Force and the U.S. Marshal's D.C. Special Response Team arrested the accused, identified as Jamal Dana **ALLEN** at his home in Manassas. The investigation continues

Charged with **2nd degree murder** and **use of a firearm in commission of a felony**

Court date: **Pending** | Status: **Held WITHOUT Bond**

Homicide Investigation [Previously Released]- On June 25 at 8:47PM, officers responded to the 7900 block of Community Dr in Manassas (20109) to investigate what was initially reported as a crash. Arriving officers quickly located a vehicle that had crashed into an unoccupied, parked car. As officers approached the vehicle they located the victim, an 18-year-old man, in the driver's seat of the vehicle with a gunshot wound to the upper body. The man was pronounced dead on scene. The suspects left the area and were not immediately located. **Preliminarily, this incident does not appear to be random. Detectives are asking anyone with any information, or anyone who may have witnessed the incident, to contact police.** Additional information will be released when available. The investigation continues.

Murder Investigation *ADDITIONAL ARREST- Detectives have obtained additional charges in connection to the ongoing investigation into the 18-year-old man who was killed during a shooting that occurred in the area of Peppertree Ln and Pebble Ln in Manassas (20111) on June 15. On July 1, Prince William County detectives, with the assistance of The Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives and the U.S. Marshal's Task Force, arrested the accused, identified as a **17-year-old male juvenile**, at his home in Manassas Park. The investigation continues.

Murder Investigation *ARRESTS [Previously Released] – Prince William County detectives have charged two individuals in connection to the shooting death of an 18-year-old Manassas man that occurred in the area of Peppertree Ln and Pebble Ln in Manassas (20111) on June 15. Following the investigation, detectives obtained charges and both individuals, identified as Markiss Alexander **MEDRANO** and a **16-year-old male juvenile**, were arrested. The investigation continues.

Homicide Investigation [Previously Released]- On June 15 at 9:57PM, officers responded to the area of Old Centreville Rd and Parkland St in Manassas (20111) to investigate a report of shots fired. During the initial investigation, officers determined a shooting occurred in the nearby Bull Run Mobile Home Community, in the area of Peppertree Ln and Pebble Ln. The investigation revealed the victim, an 18-year-old man, was in the area when he was shot in the upper body. Following the encounter, the victim attempted to leave the area and collapsed in the backyard of a nearby residence on Parrish Ln. Officers located the victim, attempted life-saving measures and ultimately, the victim was pronounced dead on scene. The suspects left the area and were not immediately located. Additionally, during the investigation a residence located in the 7400 block of Peppertree Ln was found to be struck by gunfire. **Preliminarily, this incident does not appear to be random. Detectives are asking anyone with any information, or anyone who may have witnessed the incident, to contact police.** Additional information will be released when available. The investigation continues.

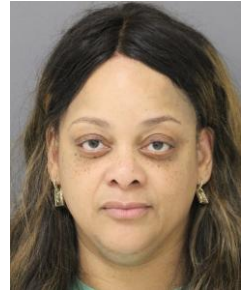

Arrests

Child Neglect- On July 1 at 3:55PM, officers responded to the 8100 block of Flannery Ct in Manassas (20109) to investigate a report of child neglect. The investigation revealed the victim, an 8-year-old girl, was left in a vehicle by a family member, later identified as the accused. The victim was left inside the vehicle for nearly an hour. During that time, the vehicle was not running and was parked in direct sunlight. The victim was able to exit the vehicle to seek assistance and was uninjured. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Dania **BOLTE THOMAS**, was arrested.
