### Incidents

**Death Investigation-** On July 4 at 3:50PM, officers responded to a parking garage located in the 13100 block of Marina Wy in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a report of an unconscious individual. The investigation revealed the individual, an 84-year-old woman, was located unconscious in a vehicle. The woman was pronounced dead on scene. Preliminarily, there were no signs of foul play or threat to the community concerning the death. More information regarding the investigation will be released if deemed necessary.

**Reckless Handling of a Firearm-** On July 6 at 12:01PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 17500 block of Isle Royale Ter in Dumfries (22025) to investigate a report of shots fired. The investigation revealed a gunshot was fired, which struck the home. Officers located shell casings in a wooded area near the 4100 block of Yellowstone Lp. No injuries or other property damage were reported. No suspect description could be provided.

**Reckless Handling of a Firearm-** On July 4 at 9:13PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 5600 block of Smallwood Ct in Woodbridge (22193) for a report of shots fired. The investigation revealed a gunshot was fired which struck the home. No injuries or additional property damage were reported. Officers located the fired bullet inside the residence. No suspect description could be provided.

**Attempted Residential Burglary-** On July 3, officers responded to a residence located in the 18000 block of Beech Ln in Triangle (22172) to investigate an attempted burglary. The investigation revealed at approximately 7:45AM that morning, the front glass door to the residence was shattered. No entry was made into the home, and no property was reported missing. No suspect description could be provided.

**Unlawful Entry-** On July 5, officers responded to a residence located in the 13100 block of Putnam Cir in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an unlawful entry. The investigation revealed at 5:00AM that morning, an unknown man entered the residence by damaging and removing the screen to a basement window, before leaving the residence through the front door. No additional property damage was reported, and no items were reported missing. The suspect was described as a white male, with black hair, wearing a black crop-top, blue jeans and black socks.

**Indecent Exposure-** On July 6, officers responded to investigate an indecent exposure that was reported to have occurred in the area of Princedale Dr and Copen Dr in Woodbridge (22193) at approximately 12:25AM. The investigation revealed the victim, a 48-year-old woman, was walking to her vehicle when she observed an unknown man standing at the above intersection. During the encounter, the suspect exposed himself to the victim and made obscene gestures. As the victim entered her vehicle and began to drive away, the suspect briefly followed her before leaving the area on foot. The suspect was described as a black male wearing a white shirt and blue shorts.

**Unlawful Recording-** On July 5 at 1:01PM, officers responded to 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave Thrift Store, located at 13770 Smoketown Rd in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a report of unlawful filming. The investigation revealed the victim, a 56-year-old woman, was in the store when she was informed by a customer that an unknown man hiding between the clothing racks was inappropriately filming her. The victim confronted the suspect, who left the area on foot. No physical contact or injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male, 5'8", with facial hair, wearing a black t-shirt and dark colored pants.

## Arrests

**Aggravated Malicious Wounding-** On July 5 at 8:17AM, officers responded to Elevations One Apartments, located in the 1900 block of Stevens Rd in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a shooting. The investigation revealed the victim, a 32-year-old man, and an acquaintance, later identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation the night prior. The next morning, the accused went back to the above area to confront the victim. During the encounter, the accused produced a firearm and shot the victim multiple times. The victim sustained life-threatening injuries and was transported to an area hospital for treatment. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Malik **JACKSON**, was arrested.

**Malicious Wounding-** On July 3 at 5:08PM, officers responded to the Nordstrom Rack, located at 2700 Potomac Mills Cir in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate an assault. The investigation revealed the victim, a 73-year-old man, was inside the store when he observed an unknown man, later identified as the accused, and a woman exit the store with unpaid merchandise. As the accused left the store, the victim took out his phone and followed the accused. The accused then assaulted the victim and damaged his phone, before leaving the area in a vehicle. The victim sustained injuries and was treated at the scene by medics. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as James Alexander **CASTELL**, was arrested.



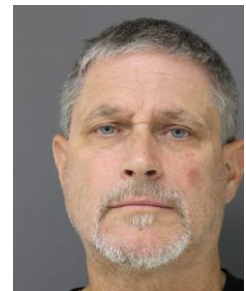

**Brandishing-** On July 4, officers responded to the 3000 block of Seminole Rd in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a brandishing that was reported to have occurred at approximately 9:30PM that night. The investigation revealed a group of adults and children were legally setting off fireworks when a neighbor, identified as the accused, approached them. During the encounter, the accused brandished a firearm at two victims, an 11-year-old boy and 41-year-old man. The victims were able to separate from the accused and leave the area before reporting the incident. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Joseph Benjamin **GRAY**, was arrested.

**Unlawful Recording-** On July 2 at 6:00PM, officers responded to the Dollar Tree located at 13345 Worth Ave in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate an assault. The investigation revealed the victims, a 19-year-old woman and 21-year-old woman, were in the store when they observed an unknown man, later identified as the accused, inappropriately filming them. One of the victims then notified a male family member, who confronted the accused. During the encounter, the accused became aggressive and an altercation ensued between the two men, before the accused left the area. Minor injuries were reported by the family member. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Pedro **ALVARADO**, was arrested.
