

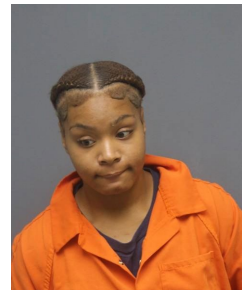

Murder Investigation *ADDITIONAL ARRESTS- Detectives have obtained additional charges in connection to the ongoing investigation into the 18-year-old man who was killed during a shooting that occurred in the area of Peppertree Ln and Pebble Ln in Manassas (20111) on June 15. Following the investigation, detectives obtained charges and four individuals, identified as **15-year-old male juvenile**, T’Kiyah Serenity **FRENCH**, Ja Quad Dyzae **ANDREWS WASHINGTON** and Austin Wainaina **WYMAN**, were arrested. Additional details regarding this incident will be released when available. The investigation continues.

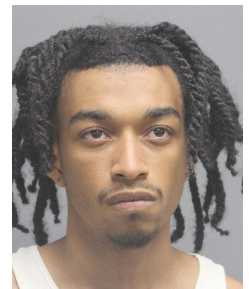

**Continuation of the investigative update from the previous page*

Homicide Investigation [Previously Released]- On June 15 at 9:57PM, officers responded to the area of Old Centreville Rd and Parkland St in Manassas (20111) to investigate a report of shots fired. During the initial investigation, officers determined a shooting occurred in the nearby Bull Run Mobile Home Community, in the area of Peppertree Ln and Pebble Ln. The investigation revealed the victim, an 18-year-old man, was in the area when he was shot in the upper body. Following the encounter, the victim attempted to leave the area and collapsed in the backyard of a nearby residence on Parrish Ln. Officers located the victim, attempted life-saving measures and ultimately, the victim was pronounced dead on scene. The suspects left the area and were not immediately located. Additionally, during the investigation a residence located in the 7400 block of Peppertree Ln was found to be struck by gunfire. **Preliminarily, this incident does not appear to be random. Detectives are asking anyone with any information, or anyone who may have witnessed the incident, to contact police.** Additional information will be released when available. The investigation continues.
