Updates

Commercial Burglary *ARREST- On July 17, detectives concluded an investigation into a burglary that occurred at Tobacco & More located at 7385 Miramar Dr in Manassas (20109) on January 26, 2025. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Antony Josue **ALDANA**, was arrested.

Commercial Burglaries [Previously Released] – On January 26 at 4:15AM, officers responded to Tobacco & More located at 7385 Miramar Dr. in Manassas (20109) to investigate an alarm activation. The investigation revealed forced entry was made into the business through the front door. Tobacco products were reported missing. While checking the area, officers determined the front door to a second Tobacco & More store located at 8335 Sudley Rd. was damaged. No entry was made into the business, and no property was reported missing.

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Incidents

Fatal Crash Investigation- On July 18 at 10:53PM, officers responded to the area of Old Bridge Rd and Colby Dr in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a crash. The investigation revealed the operator of a 2014 Yamaha CYL - (M) YZF-R1, identified as a 36-year-old man, was traveling eastbound on Old Bridge Rd, approaching Colby Dr. The operator attempted to navigate a right curve in the roadway and crossed into the median, before striking a metal sign and guardrail. The operator of the Yamaha was transported to an area hospital where he later died. Speed is believed to be a factor in this crash. **Crash investigators are asking anyone who may have witnessed this crash to contact police.**

Shooting Investigation- On July 18 at 2:22AM, officers responded to Center Plaza shopping center, located in the 4300 block of Dale Blvd in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a shooting. The investigation revealed the victim, a 33- year-old man, was walking in the parking lot when he was struck by gunfire. The victim sustained injuries and was transported to an area hospital for treatment. No suspect information was available.

Indecent Exposure- On July 17, officers responded to investigate an indecent exposure that was reported to have occurred in the 5700 block of Tavenner Mill Cir in Woodbridge (22193) on July 16 at approximately 4:30AM. The investigation revealed the victim, a 36-year-old woman, was walking her dog when she observed an unknown man acting erratically. The victim went back inside her apartment and when she looked out the window, she observed the suspect exposing himself and making obscene gestures. The suspect was described as a black male in his 30's, with shoulder length dreadlocks, wearing a black t-shirt, black pants, black Nike boots and a black beanie hat.

Arrests

Attempted Carjacking | Attempted Abduction- On July 17, at 9:11PM, officers responded to the 15000 block of Potomac Town Pl in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate an attempted carjacking. The investigation revealed the victims, a 23-year-old man and 3-year-old child, were in their vehicle when they were approached by an unknown man, later identified as the accused. During the encounter, the accused, who was found to be intoxicated, pulled on the car door handle and attempted to enter the vehicle. When the adult victim and a family member exited the vehicle to confront the accused, he again attempted to enter the vehicle where the 3-year-old child was still seated, before leaving the area on foot. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Antony Francisco **BANEGAS**, was arrested.

Assault and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]- On July 18 at 5:25AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 4000 block of Tarpon Ln in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a report of a domestic dispute. As officers arrived at the residence, one of the involved parties, later identified as the accused, impeded officers' ability to enter the residence and pushed an officer, before being taken into custody. No injuries were reported by the officer. During a search of the accused, an illicit substance was found on his person. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Luis Fernando **PEREZ MOLINA**, was arrested.

Brandishing- On July 17 at 7:10PM, officers responded to residence located in the 14600 block of Minnieville Rd in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a report of brandishing. The investigation revealed the victim, a 45-year-old man, responded to the address to check on his adult daughter, who had made concerning statements. During the encounter, an unknown man, later identified as the accused, became aggressive towards the victim and chased him out of the house before brandishing a firearm. No shots were fired and no injuries were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Julian Anthony Mekhi **MENDEZ**, was arrested.
