

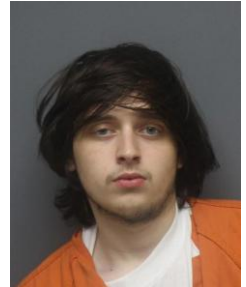

Murder Investigation *ADDITIONAL ARREST- Detectives have obtained additional charges in connection to the ongoing investigation into the 18-year-old man who was killed during a shooting that occurred in the area of Peppertree Ln and Pebble Ln in Manassas (20111) on June 15. On July 21, the accused, identified as Jaiden Juel **FRANCE**, was arrested.

Murder Investigation *ADDITIONAL ARREST [Previously Released]- Detectives have obtained additional charges in connection to the ongoing investigation into the 18-year-old man who was killed during a shooting that occurred in the area of Peppertree Ln and Pebble Ln in Manassas (20111) on June 15. On July 1, Prince William County detectives, with the assistance of The Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives and the U.S. Marshal’s Task Force arrested the accused, identified as a **17-year-old male juvenile**, at his home in Manassas Park. Murder Investigation *ARRESTS [Previously Released] – Prince William County detectives have charged two individuals in connection to the shooting death of an 18-year-old Manassas man that occurred in the area of Peppertree Ln and Pebble Ln in Manassas (20111) on June 15. Following the investigation, detectives obtained charges and both individuals, identified as Markiss Alexander **MEDRANO** and a **16-year-old male juvenile**, were arrested. The investigation continues.

Homicide Investigation [Previously Released]- On June 15 at 9:57PM, officers responded to the area of Old Centreville Rd and Parkland St in Manassas (20111) to investigate a report of shots fired. During the initial investigation, officers determined a shooting occurred in the nearby Bull Run Mobile Home Community, in the area of Peppertree Ln and Pebble Ln. The investigation revealed the victim, an 18-year-old man, was in the area when he was shot in the upper body. Following the encounter, the victim attempted to leave the area and collapsed in the backyard of a nearby residence on Parrish Ln. Officers located the victim, attempted life-saving measures and ultimately, the victim was pronounced dead on scene. The suspects left the area and were not immediately located. Additionally, during the investigation a residence located in the 7400 block of Peppertree Ln was found to be struck by gunfire. **Preliminarily, this incident does not appear to be random. Detectives are asking anyone with any information, or anyone who may have witnessed the incident, to contact police.** Additional information will be released when available. The investigation continues.

Brandishing Investigations | Impersonating Law Enforcement- On July 19, officers responded to the area of Dale Blvd and Forestdale Ave in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate brandishing that was reported to have occurred at 9:00PM that evening. The investigation revealed the victim, a 25-year-old man, was driving on Dale Blvd when he was approached by an unknown man. During the encounter, the suspect displayed a firearm and stated he was a police officer, before asking for a ride. The victim was able to leave the area before reporting the incident to police. Separately, on July 20, a 21-year-old man reported on July 19 at 9:06PM, an unknown man brandished a firearm towards him in the area of Darbydale Ave and Dale Blvd. No injuries were reported and no shots were fired in either encounter. The suspect was described as a white male, approximately 5'6", wearing a dark-colored hat, dark-colored shirt with a white shirt underneath, and dark-colored shorts.
