Incidents

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On July 26 at 9:50PM, officers responded to the 13300 block of Old Church Rd in Nokesville (20181) to investigate a report of shots fired. The investigation revealed the victim, a 47-year-old man, was driving home with his wife and 9-year-old child when their vehicle was struck by gunfire. No injuries or additional property damage were reported. No suspect information was available.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On July 25 at 3:07AM, officers responded to the 10400 block of Butterfield St in Manassas (20109) to investigate a report of shots fired. The investigation revealed the victim, a 27-year-old man, was backing into a parking space when he heard multiple gunshots. The victim left the area, and a short time later observed his vehicle had been struck by gunfire. An additional unoccupied vehicle in the parking lot was also found to be struck by gunfire. No injuries or additional property damage were reported. No suspect information was available.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On July 24, officers responded to the 8700 block of McGrath Rd in Manassas (20112) to investigate a report of shots fired. The investigation revealed on July 23 at approximately 1:40, multiple gunshots were heard and a residence was later found to have been struck by gunfire. Multiple shell casings were located in the area. No injuries or additional property damage were reported.

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Arrests

Fatal Crash Investigation | Reckless Driving- On July 24 at 7:15PM, officers responded to the area of Nokesville Rd and Fauquier Dr in Nokesville (20181) to investigate a crash. The investigation revealed the driver of a 2021 Freightliner M2 was traveling northbound on Nokesville Rd, approaching Fauquier Dr and failed to see an uninvolved vehicle that was stopped in the northbound lane, waiting to make a left turn onto Fauquier Dr. The driver of the Freightliner attempted to slow down and crossed over the dividing line, into the southbound lane, before striking the driver of a 2010 Ford F-150 that was traveling in the southbound lane. The driver of the Ford F-150, a 94-year-old man, was transported to an area hospital where he later succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased on July 26. Crash investigators are asking anyone who may have witnessed this crash to contact police. Following the investigation, the driver of the Freightliner M2, identified as Corey Latel **HEFLIN**, was charged.

Assault and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]- On July 26, officers responded to the 14400 block of Aden Rd in Nokesville (20181) to investigate a single-vehicle crash. During the investigation, the driver, later identified as the accused, was determined to be intoxicated and was detained by officers. The accused was transported to an area hospital where she became aggressive and assaulted an officer twice before being secured. No injuries were reported by the officer. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Loreta Martha Awino **WAZIRI**, was arrested.

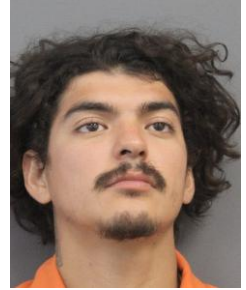

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Assault and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]- On July 26 at 3:07AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 4500 block of Hendricks Dr in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a report of a person in crisis. Arriving officers received permission from an occupant of the home to enter the residence to check on the individual, later identified as the accused. As officers entered the residence, the accused became aggressive, and assaulted an officer, before being detained. No injuries were reported by the officer. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Mike Alan **FLORES**, was arrested.
