Updates

Murder Investigation *ARREST- Prince William County detectives have charged a man in connection to the shooting death of a 16-year-old male juvenile that occurred in the 16700 block of Blackjack Oak Ln in Woodbridge (22191) on July 5. On July 30 Prince William County detectives, with the assistance of the U.S. Marshals arrested the accused, identified as Damon Jamon **ATWATER** at this home in Woodbridge. The investigation continues.



Arrested on July 30:

Damon Jamon **ATWATER**, 25, of Woodbridge

Charged with **2nd degree murder** and **use of a firearm in commission of a felony**

Homicide Investigation [Previously Released]- On July 5 at 10:12PM, officers responded to the 16700 block of Blackjack Oak Ln in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a shooting. Arriving officers located the victim, a 16-year-old male juvenile, in a parking lot in the above area with a gunshot wound to the upper body and immediately rendered aid. The victim was transported to an area hospital where he later died from his injuries. A possible involved vehicle was reportedly seen leaving the area following the shooting. Later that evening, officers observed a vehicle matching the description of the suspect vehicle on Cardinal Dr near Emil Ct where a vehicle stop was attempted. The driver refused to stop for officers and a pursuit was initiated. The driver continued to the area of Powell's Creek Blvd and Blue Pool Ln where the driver then stopped the vehicle and fled on foot. The driver was not immediately located. **Preliminarily, this incident does not appear to be random, and detectives are asking anyone with information to contact police.** Additional information will be released when available. The investigation continues.

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Incidents

Fatal Crash Investigation- On July 29 at 9:41PM, officers responded to the area of Prince William Pkwy and Nokesville Rd in Manassas (20110) to investigate a crash. The investigation revealed the operator of a 2011 Suzuki GSX-R750 motorcycle, a 37-year-old man, and the driver of a 2008 Kenworth dump truck were both traveling east on Prince William Pkwy in the center lane. The operator of the Suzuki was traveling at a high rate of speed and collided with the rear of the dump truck. Arriving officers attempted life-saving measures and ultimately, the operator of the Suzuki was pronounced deceased at the scene. The driver of the Kenworth was uninjured. **Crash investigators are asking anyone who may have witnessed this crash to contact police.**

Death Investigation- On July 29 at 6:47PM, officers responded to the Opitz Parking Garage, located at 2450 Neabsco Stream Dr in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a report of an individual in crisis. Arriving officers located the individual, identified as a 38-year-old man, on the fifth-floor ledge of the garage and attempted to speak with him. During the encounter, the man jumped from the fifth story ledge to the ground below. The man was located unconscious by officers who attempted first-aid. The man was ultimately pronounced deceased on scene. Preliminarily, there were no signs of foul play concerning the death. More information regarding the investigation will be released if deemed necessary.

Brandishing- On July 30 at 1:46AM, officers responded to the area of Sudley Rd and Sudley Manor Dr in Manassas (20109) to investigate a report of brandishing. The investigation revealed the victim, a 29-year-old man, was in his vehicle at the above intersection when the driver of a blue Honda Civic pulled up next to him. During the encounter, the suspect brandished a firearm at the victim and followed him for distance, before the parties separated. No shots were fired and no injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male, heavy set, wearing dark clothing and a ski mask on top of his head.

Vandalism on School Grounds- On July 29, officers responded to Patriot High School located at 10504 Kettle Run Rd in Nokesville (20181) to investigate a report of vandalism. The investigation revealed between June 12 and July 27, a swastika and derogatory lettering were written in marker on a stall in the boy's restroom. School personnel removed the lettering from the stall.

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Arrests

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On July 30, officers concluded an investigation into a reckless handling of a firearm that was reported to have occurred in the 14300 block of N. Park Ct in Woodbridge (22193) on July 22 at 7:38PM. The investigation revealed a 15-year-old male juvenile and a 12-year-old boy were playing basketball when they were approached by an unknown male juvenile, identified as the accused. The accused asked the boys if they knew the whereabouts of the victim, a 16-year-old male juvenile. During the encounter, the accused observed the victim in the area, brandished a firearm at the victim and fired two gunshots in the air. No injuries were reported. The three juveniles were able to leave the area and report the encounter. Following the investigation, officers obtained warrants and the accused, identified as a **16-year-old male juvenile**, was arrested.

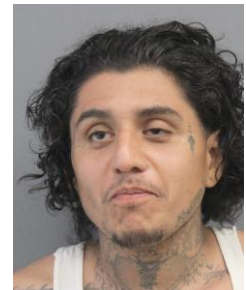

Indecent Exposure- On July 28 at 5:07PM, officers responded to the Broadstone Apartments, located at 3100 Chesapeake Dr in Dumfries (22026) to investigate an indecent exposure. The investigation revealed the victims, an 11-year-old boy and 8-year-old boy, were sitting on a bench, when an unknown man, later identified as the accused, sat down next to them. During the encounter, the accused exposed himself and made obscene gestures in view of the victims. The two victims both left the area and went inside the apartment complex. Arriving officers quickly located the accused, who was determined to be intoxicated, and took him into custody. Following the investigation the accused, identified as Kevin Ernesto **MARCHANTE**, was arrested.
