

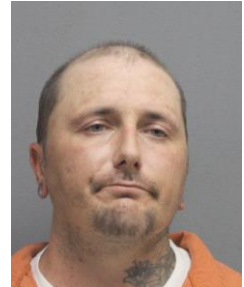

Updates

Brandishing Investigations | Impersonating Law Enforcement *ARREST- On July 30, the suspect sought in connection to a brandishing that was reported to have occurred in the area of Dale Blvd and Forestdale Ave in Woodbridge (22193) on July 19, was arrested. During the investigation, officers were able to identify the suspect and obtained warrants. The accused, identified as James John **RASTATTER** II, was subsequently located and taken into custody on July 30.



Arrested on July 30:

James John **RASTATTER** II, 35, of Woodbridge

Charged with two counts of **brandishing**, one count of **impersonating a law enforcement officer**, and one count of **possession of a firearm by a convicted felon**

Brandishing Investigations | Impersonating Law Enforcement [Previously Released]- On July 19, officers responded to the area of Dale Blvd and Forestdale Ave in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate brandishing that was reported to have occurred at 9:00PM that evening. The investigation revealed the victim, a 25-year-old man, was driving on Dale Blvd when he was approached by an unknown man. During the encounter, the suspect displayed a firearm and stated he was a police officer, before asking for a ride. The victim was able to leave the area before reporting the incident to police. Separately, on July 20, a 21-year-old man reported on July 19 at 9:06PM, an unknown man brandished a firearm towards him in the area of Darbydale Ave and Dale Blvd. No injuries were reported and no shots were fired in either encounter. The suspect was described as a white male, approximately 5'6", wearing a dark-colored hat, dark-colored shirt with a white shirt underneath, and dark-colored shorts.

Arrests

Assault & Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]- On July 30 at 7:39PM, an officer working an off-duty detail at Wegmans located at 14801 Dining Way in Woodbridge (22191) was advised by store staff of a shoplifting in progress. The investigation revealed two juveniles concealed merchandise before they exited the store. When the officer attempted to detain the juveniles, both attempted to flee on foot. One juvenile fled and was not located. The other juvenile, later identified as the accused, was detained after throwing an object at an officer which struck the officer in the face. Minor injuries were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as a **16-year-old male juvenile**, was arrested.
