Murder Investigation *ARREST- On August 2, the suspect sought in connection to the murder of a 21-year-old Gainesville man during a domestic altercation at a home located in the 13400 block of Grayson Hill Cir in Woodbridge (22193) on July 27, was arrested. The accused, identified as Thomas Lynwood **BROWN**, was apprehended at a location on Westfields Blvd in Centreville by members of the U.S. Marshals Fugitive Task Force.

Homicide Investigation [Previously Released]- On July 27 at 9:12PM, officers responded to The Fitzgerald apartments, located in the 13400 block of Grayson Hill Cir in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a domestic dispute involving weapons. The investigation revealed the victim, a 21-year-old man, was involved in an altercation with a family member, identified as the accused. During the encounter, the accused produced a firearm and shot the victim in the upper body, before leaving the area. Arriving officers provided aid to the victim, and ultimately, the victim was pronounced dead on scene. Following the investigation, detectives obtained arrest warrants for the accused identified as Thomas Lynwood **BROWN**. Attempts to locate the accused were unsuccessful. **Detectives are asking anyone with any information, or anyone who may have witnessed the incident, to contact police.** Additional information will be released when available. The investigation continues.

Homicide Investigation- On August 1 at 2:02AM, officers responded to investigate a shooting that was reported to have occurred in the 14100 block of Crossing Pl in Woodbridge (22192) earlier that morning. The investigation revealed there was large car meet at the location when a shooting occurred where the victim, a **16-year-old male juvenile**, was struck in the upper body. The victim was taken to an area hospital where police were notified of the incident. Officers then responded to the above area of the shooting, locating shell casings and evidence of an altercation. All other parties had dispersed prior to officers arriving on scene. On August 2, investigators learned the victim had succumbed to their injuries at the hospital. An autopsy completed the following day confirmed the manner of death was homicide. No suspect information is available at this time. **Detectives are asking anyone with any information, or anyone who may have witnessed the incident, to contact police.** Due to the age of the deceased, their identity will not be publicly disclosed by law enforcement. Additional information will be released when available. The investigation continues.

Aggravated Malicious Wounding- On August 2 at 10:36PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 15500 block of Lebourget Ct in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a shooting. The investigation revealed the victim, an 18-year-old woman, and a juvenile family member, identified as the accused, were involved in verbal altercation that escalated. During the encounter, the accused retrieved a firearm from within the home and confronted the victim, firing one round and grazing the victim to their upper body. The accused then left the home prior to officers arriving on scene. A police K-9 searched the area for the accused who was not located. The victim was transported to an area hospital where her injuries were determined to be non-life threatening. Following the investigation, officers obtained detention orders for the accused, identified as a **13-year-old male juvenile**. Due to the age of the accused, their identity will not be publicly disclosed by law enforcement. Further attempts to locate the accused have been unsuccessful.

Strong-Arm Robbery- On August 2 at 11:47AM, officers responded to the 7-Eleven located at 13990 Richmond Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed an unknown man concealed merchandise and attempted to leave the store when he was confronted by a store employee. During the encounter, a struggle ensued between the man and employee before the parties separated and the suspect left. No injuries were reported. Alcohol was reported missing.

Indecent Exposure- On August 1 at 4:13PM, officers responded to Ollies located at 8351 Sudley Rd in Manassas (20109) to investigate an indecent exposure. The investigation revealed an employee of the business was exiting a rear room when they observed an unknown man urinating on the floor in the store. The man then turned and further exposed himself to the employee before exiting the business. No physical contact occurred and no injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a white male between 60-70 years of age and approximately 5'8" wearing a white shirt, orange shorts and back shoes.

Residential Burglary- On August 1 at 5:33PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 12500 block of Armada Pl in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a burglary. The investigation revealed sometime between 12:00PM and 3:00PM, the residence was entered through a bedroom window that was found damaged. Jewelry and a firearm were reported missing.

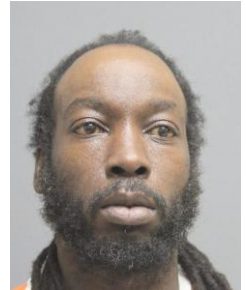

Arrests

Shooting in Public | Shooting into an Occupied Dwelling- On July 31 at 11:32PM, officers responded to the 3100 block of Antrim Cir in Dumfries (22026) to investigate a shots fired call. The investigation revealed the accused had been in a verbal argument with a female acquaintance before being dropped off at a residence in the above area. As the acquaintance drove away, multiple gunshots were heard. Officers arrived in the area and located several shell casings and determined two residences had been struck. No injuries were reported. Officers conducted an extensive search of the area, ultimately locating the accused in a wooded area near Richmond Hwy and Wayside Dr where he was detained without further incident. A search of a nearby residence where the accused resided resulted in multiple firearms and narcotics being located. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Derrick Alexander **MARKS**, was arrested.

Possession of Child Pornography- On July 30, officers concluded an investigation involving the solicitation and possession of child pornography that stemmed from inappropriate communication between a juvenile in the Woodbridge (22192) area of Prince William County and the suspect who resided in Somerset County, NJ. In May 2026, officers learned of the inappropriate communication between the 16-year-old female victim and the suspect which occurred over social media app SnapChat. Further details revealed the suspect had solicited and obtained pornographic images of the victim during their communication. Following the investigation, officers obtained warrants for the suspect, identified as Stephen **MILLER**, who was located and detained by Somerset County law enforcement in New Jersey. On July 30, the accused was extradited to Prince William County and served on charges stemming from the investigation.



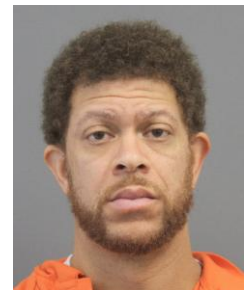

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On August 2 at 11:06PM, officers responded to the 8000 block of Deward Ct in Manassas (20109) to investigate a shots fired call. The investigation revealed the accused, fired two rounds from a handgun into the ground. Officers arrived and detained the accused at his vehicle in the area of Deward Ct and Portsmouth Rd. A firearm was also recovered. No injuries or property damage were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Roger Curtis **BROWN**, was arrested.

Brandishing a Firearm – On July 31 at 2:25PM, officers responded to the 14700 block of Darbydale Ave in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a road rage incident. The investigation revealed the victim, a 52-year-old man, and the driver of another vehicle, later identified as the accused, were involved in verbal altercation following an encounter on the roadway. Both parties pulled over in the above area where the accused approached the victim's vehicle and reached for an item the victim believed was a firearm. No shots were fired and no injuries were reported. A short time later, officers located the accused and recovered a firearm. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Vincent Edward **THOMPSON**, was charged.

Indecent Exposure- On August 1, officers concluded an investigation into an indecent exposure that was reported to have occurred in the area of Ivy Stone Pl and Potomac Branch Dr in Woodbridge (22191) on July 27 at approximately 7:17PM. The investigation revealed the victim, a 29-year-old man and a 29-year-old woman, were walking their child in the above area when they observed an unknown man, later identified as the accused, exit his vehicle and begin urinating on the ground in proximately of the victims and other children in the area. When one of the victims yelled towards the accused, he turned and further exposed himself to them before getting back in his vehicle and leaving the area. A license plate was obtained of the vehicle, and officers were able to identify the accused and obtain charges. On August 1, the accused, identified as Baba **ALLIE**, turned himself into police.
