Strangulation (Domestic Related) *ARREST- On August 1, 2026, the suspect sought in connection to a domestic assault that was reported to have occurred at a residence located in the 14400 block of Filarete St. in Woodbridge (22193) on June 29, 2024, was arrested. The accused, identified as Wilson **SALINAS-BARRERA**, was taken into custody by Virginia State Police in Chesapeake, VA.

Strangulation (Domestic Related) [Previously Released] On June 29, [2024] at 2:28PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 14400 block of Filarete St. in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a domestic dispute. The investigation revealed the victim, a 25-year-old woman, and an acquaintance, identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation that escalated. During the encounter, the accused struck and kicked the victim multiple times before grabbing her neck. The parties eventually separated, and the accused left the area. Minor injuries were reported. Following the investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants for the accused, identified as Wilson **SALINAS-BARRERA**. Attempts to locate the accused have been unsuccessful.

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Incidents

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On August 4 at 2:46AM, officers were made aware of a shots fired call that was reported to have occurred in the parking lot of the Sleep Inn located at 14080 Shoppers Best Way in Woodbridge (22192) the day prior, on August 3 at approximately 9:00AM. The investigation revealed the victims, a 37-year-old man and a 40-year-old woman, were sleeping in their vehicle that was parked in the parking lot when they were approached by an unknown man. During the encounter, a verbal altercation ensued before the man pulled out a firearm and shot a single round, striking the vehicle. The incident was not immediately reported to police by the victims. Officers did respond to the area due to a third-party call of the shooting. The victims were not present, and no evidence of a shooting was found at that time. On August 4, the victims were stopped by police for an unrelated traffic offense where the incident was disclosed. No injuries or other property damage were reported. The suspect was described as a black male, with fair skin, brown eyes, long dreadlocks, approximately 6'0, 18lbs, and bulky build.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On August 3 at 9:50AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 4100 block of Yellow Stone Lp in Dumfries (22025) to investigate a destruction of property. The investigation revealed the homeowner had located a bullet hole in a bedroom wall while moving furniture. No shots fired calls had been reported in the area overnight, and no other injuries or property damage were reported. The incident may have been related to a prior shots fired call on Isle Royale Ter that was reported on July 6.
