Aggravated Malicious Wounding *ARREST- On August 4, the juvenile suspect sought in connection to the domestic-related shooting that was reported to have occurred at a home located in the 15500 block of Lebourget Ct in Woodbridge (22193) on August 2, was arrested.

Arrested on August 4: [juvenile]

A **13-year-old male juvenile** of Woodbridge

Charged with **aggravated malicious wounding, use of a firearm in commission of a felony, shooting in an occupied dwelling**, and **juvenile possession of a firearm**

Aggravated Malicious Wounding- On August 2 at 10:36PM, officers responded to a residence located in the 15500 block of Lebourget Ct in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a shooting. The investigation revealed the victim, an 18-year-old woman, and a juvenile family member, identified as the accused, were involved in verbal altercation that escalated. During the encounter, the accused retrieved a firearm from within the home and confronted the victim, firing one round and grazing the victim to their upper body. The accused then left the home prior to officers arriving on scene. A police K-9 searched the area for the accused who was not located. The victim was transported to an area hospital where her injuries were determined to be non-life threatening. Following the investigation, officers obtained detention orders for the accused, identified as a **13-year-old male juvenile**. Due to the age of the accused, their identity will not be publicly disclosed by law enforcement. Further attempts to locate the accused have been unsuccessful.

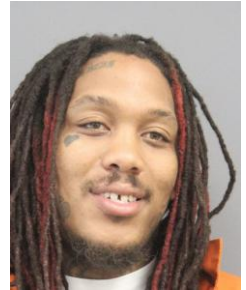

Arrests

Brandishing a Firearm- On August 3 at 2:08PM, officers responded to the Shell service station located at 4110 Dale Blvd in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a brandishing. The investigation revealed an unknown woman entered the business and concealed several items before exiting the store and walking to a vehicle occupied by an unknown man, later identified as the accused. An employee followed the woman to the vehicle and was retrieving the items when the accused brandished a firearm towards the employee. The employee returned to the business and contacted police as the suspect vehicle left the area. Officers identified the accused and obtained arrest warrants. On August 4, officers located and stopped the suspect vehicle in the area of the Prince William Pkwy and Minnieville Rd where the accused was detained without incident. Ammunition and evidence of narcotics were located inside the vehicle. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Justin Denzel **GORE**, was arrested.

Charged with one count of **brandishing a firearm**, two counts of **possession of a firearm/ammunition by a convicted felon**, two counts of **driving on a revoked license**, and one count of **possession of a scheduled I/II narcotic**
