



DAILY INCIDENT REPORT

August 6, 2026

Incidents

Death Investigation- On August 5 at 8:07PM, officers responded to the area of Oakwood Dr and Old Bridge Rd in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate an initial report of a crash. The investigation revealed the driver of 2023 Toyota 4-Runner, identified as a 75-year-old man, was traveling westbound on Old Bridge Rd approaching Oakwood Dr when the vehicle left the roadway and struck a pole at very low speed, causing minor damage. The driver is believed to have suffered a medical emergency and became unconscious just prior to the vehicle leaving the roadway. The driver was transported to an area hospital where he died. The crash does not appear to be a contributing factor in the driver's death, nor are there any signs of foul play concerning the death. More information regarding the investigation will be released if deemed necessary.

Brandishing of a Firearm- On August 5 at 4:59PM, officers responded to the area of Richmond Hwy and Occoquan Rd in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a road rage incident. The investigation revealed the victim, a 25-year-old man, was driving his vehicle on Richmond Hwy from Fairfax County when he became involved in a road rage encounter with the driver of a blue, older model vehicle, possibly a Honda Civic. As both vehicles entered Prince William County, the victim pulled into a service station along Occoquan Rd while the driver of the other vehicle was seen making a U-turn and pulling into an adjacent parking lot. The other driver then reportedly raised his arm, holding a dark colored object believed to be a firearm. The parties eventually separated. No shots were fired and no injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male, possibly in his 30s.

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Arrests

Attempt to Disarm a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]- On August 6 at 12:40AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 7800 block of Crescent Park Dr in Gainesville (20155) to investigate a domestic dispute. During the investigation, one of the parties involved, identified as the accused, was determined to have assaulted a family member and was detained. While in custody, the accused became noncompliant and, at one point, grabbed the holstered firearm of one of the officers. The firearm was never removed from the holster, and the accused was eventually secured without further incident. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as a **16-year-old female juvenile**, was arrested.

Unlawful Entry- On August 5 at 7:45PM, officers responded to the Dominion Lake Ridge Apartments located in the 3200 block of Ridge View Ct in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a burglary. The investigation revealed an unknown man, later identified as the accused, had shattered windows on two apartments before entering one of the apartments through the unlocked front door. The resident of the apartment yelled towards the accused who left the residence on foot. Responding officers located the accused who was determined to be intoxicated. No property was reported missing. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Zackary Lee **PLUMLEY**, was arrested.
