Incidents

Commercial Burglary- On August 9 at 2:48AM, officers responded to the Chick-fil-A, located at 3880 Fettle Park Dr in Dumfries (22025) to investigate an alarm activation. The investigation revealed an unknown man forcibly pulled open a side door, entered into the business and removed a stack of napkins, before leaving the area. A police K-9 searched the area for the suspect, who was not located. The suspect was described as a white male with dark hair, wearing a green t-shirt, dark colored pants and black shoes.

Commercial Burglary- On August 9 at 2:21AM, officers responded to the Tobacco Hut & Vape, located at 12518 Gordon Blvd in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate an alarm activation. The investigation revealed two unknown individuals shattered a window and entered the business. The suspects took vape products and an undisclosed amount of money before leaving the area in a vehicle. The suspects were described as two black individuals of unknown sex, wearing dark clothing, a black backpack and a pink backpack.

Arrests

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On August 8 at 1:33PM, officers responded to the 16600 block of Pleasant Rd in Triangle (22172) to investigate a report of shots fired. Responding officers located a man, later identified as the accused, inside a vehicle with a firearm in his possession. After multiple attempts to speak with the accused, officers were able to detain him without incident. Multiple shell casings were located near the vehicle. No injuries or damage to property were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Christian **STAFFORD**, was arrested.

Brandishing- On August 7, officers responded to the El Tio Restaurant, located at 7527 Linton Hall Rd in Gainesville (20155) to investigate a report of brandishing. The investigation revealed at 10:11PM that evening, a patron of the restaurant, later identified as the accused, was intoxicated and became involved in a verbal argument with another patron. During the encounter, the accused went to his vehicle, retrieved a firearm and brandished it towards multiple people in the restaurant before leaving the area in a vehicle. Officers quickly located the vehicle and detained the accused without incident. No shots were fired and no injuries were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Robert Patrick **BLOCK** Jr, was arrested.
