Incidents

Unlawful Filming- On August 10 at 7:38PM, officers responded to the Tempo by Hilton hotel located at 9849 Discovery Blvd in Manassas (20110) to investigate a suspicious person. The investigation revealed the victim, an 18-year-old woman, was using a restroom inside the hotel when she observed a phone appear under the stall. The victim exited the stall and confronted an unknown man. After a brief encounter, the man exited the bathroom and left the hotel through a side door. Officers checked the property and surrounding area for the suspect who was not located. No injuries or physical contact were reported. The victim was able to take a photo of the suspect and provide the image to police. The same man is believed to have been on the hotel premises on July 28, and had been seen around the women's restroom area. Officers responded at that time and checked the property for the suspect who was not located. No filming encounters had been reported at that time.



Suspect Description:

Black male, late teens to early 20s, 5'10", 180-200lbs with short black hair and a clean shaven face
Last seen wearing a black t-shirt with blue & yellow graphic, khakis shorts, black ankle socks, and gray & white Nike shoes

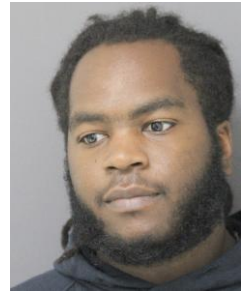
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Arrests

Brandishing a Firearm- On August 10, officers concluded an investigation into a road rage incident that was reported to have occurred in the area of the Prince William Pwky and Minnieville Rd in Woodbridge (22193) on July 31 at approximately 1:00PM. The investigation revealed the victim, a 58-year-old man, was involved in an altercation with the driver of another vehicle, later identified as the accused. At one point during the encounter, the accused brandished a firearm towards the victim, before the drivers separated. No shots were fired and no injuries were reported. The victim provided officers with a license plate of the suspect vehicle, identifying the driver. Officers obtained a warrant for the accused, identified as Brandon **SPRUILL**, who turned himself into police on August 10.
