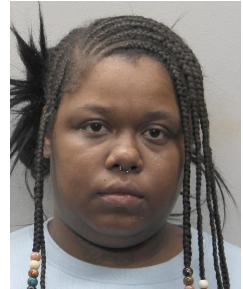
Reckless Handling of a Firearm *ARREST- The suspect sought in connection with the reckless handling of a firearm that was reported to have occurred at El Establo, located at 14440 Richmond Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) on July 26, has been arrested. On August 12, the accused, identified as Avisha Brianna **SMITH**, was taken into custody by Fairfax County police.

Arrested on August 12:

Avisha Brianna **SMITH**, 31, of Ashburn

Charged with ***willfully discharging a firearm in public*** and ***reckless handling of a firearm***

Reckless Handling of a Firearm [Previously Released]- On July 26, officers responded to El Establo, located at 14440 Richmond Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a report of shots fired. The investigation revealed at approximately 1:47AM that morning, the suspect and an acquaintance became involved in an altercation with an unknown man. During the altercation, the man struck the suspect with a cup. The suspect then went to her vehicle, grabbed her firearm from the vehicle and fired a single gunshot. No injuries or property damage were reported. Officers located a shell casing in the parking lot. Following the investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants for the suspect, identified as Avisha Brianna **SMITH**. Attempts to locate **SMITH** were unsuccessful.

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Incidents

Fatal Crash Investigation- On August 15 at 11:44PM, officers responded to the area of Dumfries Rd and Fraley Blvd in Dumfries (22026) to investigate a crash involving a pedestrian. The investigation revealed a 44-year-old man was crossing Fraley Blvd in the above area when he was struck by a 2017 Lexus RX350 that was traveling southbound. Subsequently, a 2016 BMW M4 was also traveling southbound and struck the pedestrian. Both drivers remained at the scene. At the time of the crash, the pedestrian was not in a designated crosswalk and was not wearing reflective clothing. The pedestrian died at the scene as a result of the injuries sustained in the crash. The driver of the Lexus, identified as a 32-year-old man and the driver of the BMW, identified as a 31-year-old man, were both uninjured. **Crash investigators are asking anyone who may have witnessed this crash to contact police.**

Attempted Residential Burglary- On August 16, officers responded to a residence located in the 14700 block of Darbydale Ave in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate a reported attempted burglary. The investigation revealed between August 1 and August 15, the doorknob to the rear door of the residence had been tampered with and damaged. No entry was made into the home, and no items were reported missing.

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Arrests

Assault and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]- On August 15 at 8:10PM, officers were working a concert at Jiffy Lube Live, located at 7800 Cellar Door Ln in Bristow (20136) when they responded to investigate a report of an intoxicated individual. The investigation revealed an 18-year-old woman, later identified as the accused, was intoxicated and unable to stand up without assistance. Officers detained the accused and while being handcuffed, the accused became aggressive and assaulted an officer, before being secured. No injuries were reported by the officers. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Caroline Cay **COLVIN**, was arrested.

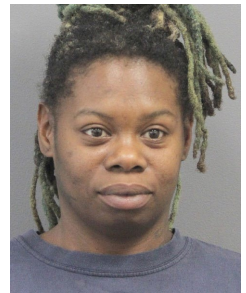

Assault and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]- On August 14 at 10:31AM, officers responded to the Motel 6, located at 17133 Dumfries Rd in Dumfries (22025) to investigate what was initially reported as a domestic dispute. The investigation revealed one of the parties, later identified as the accused, was in an intoxicated state and became aggressive and belligerent towards officers and employees. During the encounter, when officers took the accused into custody, she continued to be aggressive and assaulted two officers, before being secured. Minor injuries were reported by the officers. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Laura Shantell **TAYLOR**, was arrested.
