Incidents

Death Investigation- On August 21 at 4:01AM, officers responded to Chuys, located at 2631 Prince William Pkwy in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a report of an unconscious individual. The investigation revealed the individual, a 39-year-old man, was located unconscious in the outdoor seating area. The man was pronounced dead on scene. The restaurant was not open at the time of the incident. Preliminarily, there were no signs of foul play or threat to the community concerning the death. More information regarding the investigation will be released if deemed necessary.

Sexual Assault Investigation- On August 20 at 9:09PM, officers responded to the Food Lion, located at 12420 Dillingham Sq in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a sexual assault. The investigation revealed an employee of the business, a 35-year-old woman, was in the store when she was approached by an unknown man, later identified as the accused. During the encounter, the accused inappropriately touched the victim, and grabbed her arm, before leaving the area in a vehicle. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants for the accused, identified as Matthew Steven **PORCELLI**. Attempts to locate Matthew Stephen **PORCELLI** were unsuccessful.

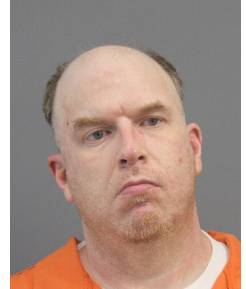
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Arrests

Impersonating Law Enforcement- On August 19, officers investigated an individual claiming to be a law enforcement officer attempting to enter a secured area of the Prince William County Police Department Central District Station, located at 5036 Davis Ford Rd in Woodbridge (22192) around 7:00PM. The investigation revealed the individual, later identified as the accused, drove up to a rear gate on the property and claimed he was an officer in an attempt to enter the secured parking lot of the station. The accused was denied entry and left the area in a vehicle. Following the investigation, officers obtained charges for the accused, identified as Matthew Bailey **THOMPSON**, who was arrested on August 20.
