

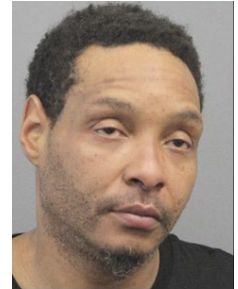


DAILY INCIDENT REPORT

August 24, 2026

Incidents

Sexual Assault Investigation- On August 19 at 10:56PM, officers responded to the 8300 block of Sudley Rd in Manassas (20109) to investigate a sexual assault. The investigation revealed the victim, a 39-year-old woman, was sexually assaulted by an acquaintance, later identified as the accused, in a wooded area near the above location. The victim was able to separate herself from the accused before reporting the incident to police. The victim sustained injuries and was transported to an area hospital for treatment. Following the investigation, detectives obtained warrants for the accused, identified as Curtis Lucas **BROWN JR**. Attempts to locate Curtis Lucas **BROWN JR** were unsuccessful.

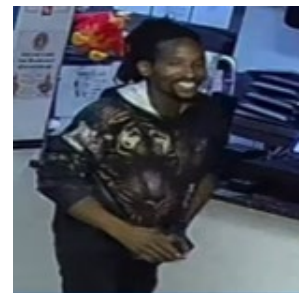
Curtis Lucas **BROWN JR**, 45, of no fixed address

Described as a black male, 5'5", 170lbs, with black hair and brown eyes

Wanted for one count of **rape**, one count of **abduction with intent to defile**, 2 counts of **strangulation**, one count of **object sexual penetration** and one count of **assault & battery**

Strong-Armed Robbery- On August 24, officers responded to the 10200 block of Farragut Ct in Manassas (20109) to investigate a robbery that was reported to have occurred on August 23 at 10:30PM. The investigation revealed the victim, a 41-year-old woman, was walking in the area when she was approached by an unknown man. During the encounter the suspect took the victim's bag, before leaving the area on foot. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a black male with a thin build, wearing a ski mask and dark clothing.

Brandishing- On August 21 at 8:22PM, officers responded to the Valvoline Instant Oil Change, located at 14103 Richmond Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate brandishing. The investigation revealed an unknown man driving a gold minivan, pulled into the parking lot, exited the vehicle and brandished a firearm towards multiple employees, before leaving the area in the vehicle. No shots were fired and no injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a black male wearing a black graphic hoodie, black pants and black shoes.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On August 23 at 6:40PM, officers responded to the 9000 block of McGuinn Ln in Nokesville (20181) to investigate a report of shots fired. The investigation revealed multiple gunshots were heard in the area and a residence was struck by gunfire. No injuries or additional damage to property were reported. The location of where the gunshots were fired could not be determined. No suspect information could be provided.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On August 22 at approximately 7:06PM, officers responded to the 17000 block of Dumfries Rd in Dumfries (22026) to investigate a report of shots fired. The investigation revealed two unknown men in a black sedan fired gunshots towards a white sedan, before both vehicles left the area. Two unoccupied vehicles were struck by the gunfire. Officers located multiple shell casings in the area. No injuries or additional damage to property were reported. The suspects were described as two black males wearing dark clothing.

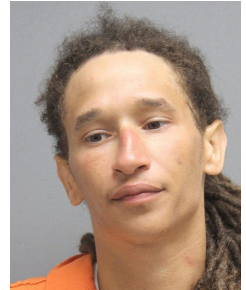

Arrests

Aggravated Malicious Wounding- On August 23 at 12:01AM, officers responded to the 16600 block of Flotilla Way in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a shooting. The investigation revealed the victim, a 27-year-old man, an individual, later identified as the accused, were involved in a verbal altercation that escalated. During the encounter, the accused produced a handgun and fired one round, grazing the victim in the upper body. The victim was transported to an area hospital where his injuries were determined to be non-life threatening. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Jrrysawn Aushaude **COOK**, was arrested.
