Incidents

Armed Robbery- On August 25, officers responded to the 1800 block of Sugar Hill Dr in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a robbery that was reported to have occurred at 4:08PM that day. The investigation revealed the victim, an Amazon delivery driver, was dropping off a package when he observed an unknown man rummaging through his vehicle. During the encounter, the suspect brandished a firearm and took multiple packages, before leaving the area on a bicycle. No injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a light-complexioned black male, 5'8" with black hair and a beard, carrying a black backpack.

Obscene Sexual Display- On August 20 at 1:38PM, officers responded to Miss Kibbles, located at 10390 Bristow Center Dr in Bristow (20136) to investigate a report of obscene sexual display. The investigation revealed an unknown man entered the store and took photographs of an employee, identified as a 33-year-old woman, before making obscene gestures and leaving the store. No physical contact or injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male, 5'7", with a medium build, wearing black gym shorts and a black shirt.
