Chrissy Fauls presented detailed information on Human Trafficking and provided each member with a printout of her presentation.

This information included the main categories of Human Trafficking to include Sex Trafficking and Labor Trafficking. Vulnerability, Grooming, and Victimization were reviewed as was methods of control. Types of traffickers (employers, familial, boyfriend/girlfriend, and gangs) was presented. Ms. Fauls discussed recognizing ownership, the prevalence of human trafficking, the AMP model, and ways to identify and reporting trafficking.

2. Simply Report- a phone app. PWC does not officially use; but can be helpful.

Board Members' Time

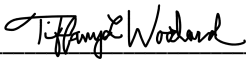
