

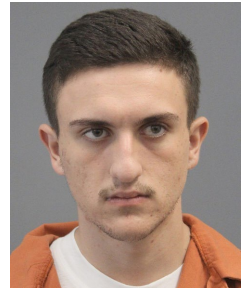

Updates

Reckless Handling of a Firearm Investigations *ARREST- On September 3, detectives concluded an investigation into two reckless handling of a firearm incidents that were reported to have occurred in the 7500 block of Bosbury Ct and the 8100 block of Claremont St in Manassas (20109) on April 21. Following the investigation, detectives obtained charges and the accused, identified as Stivan Zlatiev **DIMITROV**, was arrested.



Arrested on September 3:

Stivan Zlatiev **DIMITROV**, 20, of Bristow

Charged with one count of *shooting into an occupied dwelling*, one count of *shooting across a road*, two counts of *reckless handling of a firearm*, two counts of *shooting in public* and two counts of *destruction of property*

Reckless Handling of a Firearm [Previously Released] – On April 21 at 1:32AM, officers responded to a residence located in the 7500 block of Bosbury Ct in Manassas (20111) to investigate a shots fired call. The investigation revealed the home and homeowner's unoccupied vehicle had been struck by gunfire. No injuries or other property damage were reported. A police K-9 searched the area for possible involved parties who were not located. Shell casings were located on the property.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm [Previously Released]– On April 21 at 1:44AM, officers responded to the 8100 block of Claremont St in Manassas (20109) to investigate a shots fired call. The investigation revealed two unoccupied vehicles had been struck by gunfire. No injuries or other property damage were reported. Shell casings were located in the roadway.

Incidents

Commercial Burglary- On September 3, officers responded to the AT&T substation, located at 13898 Dumfries Rd in Manassas (20112) to investigate a reported burglary. The investigation revealed between August 26 and September 2, the lock to the fence had been cut and entry was made into the substation. Multiple electrical components including multiplex packs, power supply boxes and copper wire were reported missing. No suspect description was available.

Arrests

Abduction with Intent to Defile- On September 1, detectives concluded an investigation into a sexual assault that was reported to have occurred at a residence in the 7300 block of Yountville Dr in Gainesville (20155) on April 23. The investigation revealed the victim, a 63-year-old woman, was inside her residence for a scheduled cable installation when she was approached by the cable technician, identified as the accused. During the encounter, the accused prevented the victim from leaving a room with the intent to inappropriately touch her, before exiting the residence. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, detectives obtained arrest warrants, and the accused, identified as Luis Enrique Falconi **REVILLA**, was arrested.

Assault and Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer [LEO]- On September 4 at 12:00AM, officers responded to the 2800 block of Prince William Pkwy in Woodbridge (22192), to investigate a report of a disorderly individual. The investigation revealed the individual, later identified as the accused, was intoxicated and had been removed from a restaurant for attempting to fight patrons prior to officers' arrival. Officers detained the accused and while being seated in a police cruiser, the accused became aggressive and assaulted an officer before being secured. Minor injuries were reported by the officer. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Kevin Lawrence **CRAWFORD**, was arrested.
