Obscene Sexual Display *ARREST- On September 4, officers identified and obtained charges for the suspect sought in connection with the obscene sexual display that was reported to have occurred at Miss Kibbles, located at 10390 Bristow Center Dr in Bristow (20136) on August 20. The suspect, identified as Hamid Jan **HASSAN**, was subsequently served with a court summons on September 5.

Obscene Sexual Display [Previously Released]- On August 20 at 1:38PM, officers responded to Miss Kibbles, located at 10390 Bristow Center Dr in Bristow (20136) to investigate a report of obscene sexual display. The investigation revealed an unknown man entered the store and took photographs of an employee, identified as a 33-year old woman, before making obscene gestures and leaving the store. No physical contact or injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male, 5'7", with a medium build, wearing black gym shorts and a black shirt.

Incidents

Fatal Hit & Run Crash Investigation – On September 3 at 9:42PM, officers responded to the 14500 block of Richmond Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a crash involving two pedestrians. The investigation revealed the victims, a 28-year-old man and a 24-year-old woman, were walking through a parking lot in the above area when they were both struck by a dark-colored pick-up truck. The striking vehicle left the scene and was not located. Both pedestrians were transported to an area hospital with injuries sustained from the crash. The female victim, who was in her third trimester of pregnancy, underwent an emergency procedure which resulted in her child being delivered. The child subsequently died several hours later from injuries suspected to have resulted from the crash. Both adults are expected to recover from their injuries. **Crash investigators are asking anyone who may have witnessed this crash to contact police.**

Abduction- On September 6 at 12:33AM, officers responded to the 2700 block of Noble Fir Ct in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a reported abduction. The investigation revealed the victims, a 32-year-old woman and 25-year-old woman, requested a ride from using the Lyft app to transport them from an event in Maryland to their residence. The driver of the Lyft vehicle, later identified as the accused, picked the women up and proposed a discounted rate be paid directly to him, instead of through Lyft. While dropping off the victims, an argument ensued over the price of the ride and the accused prevented the victims from leaving the vehicle, driving a short distance, before allowing the victims to exit the vehicle. No injuries were reported by the victims. Following the investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants for the accused, identified as Adar **BULUT**. Attempted to locate **BULUT** were unsuccessful.

Death Investigation- On September 5 at 1:04PM, officers responded to the Potomac Festival Shopping Center, located in the 14500 block of Potomac Mills Rd in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a report of an unconscious individual. The investigation revealed the individual, identified as a 31-year-old man, was located unconscious in his vehicle. Medics provided aid and the man was transported to an area hospital where he later died. Preliminarily, there were no signs of foul play concerning the death. More information regarding the investigation will be released if deemed necessary.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On September 7 at 1:10AM, officers responded to the Marumsco Plaza Shopping Center, located in the 13900 block of Richmond Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a report of self-inflicted shooting. The investigation revealed the individual, identified as a 19-year-old man, was located in a vehicle with a self-inflicted gunshot wound to the upper body. Officers performed life-saving measures, and the man was transported to an area hospital for treatment of life-threatening injuries. No additional property damage or injuries were reported.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On September 6 at 2:46AM, officers responded to the 1400 block of E St in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a reported fight with weapons. The investigation revealed two unknown men in a vehicle fired gunshots towards the occupants of a nearby residence, before leaving the area in the vehicle. No injuries or property damage were reported. Officers located an unspent bullet in the roadway. The suspects were described as two men wearing dark colored clothing and ski masks.

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On September 6, officers responded to a residence located in the 14600 block of Fitzwater Dr in Nokesville (20181) to investigate a report of shots fired. The investigation revealed during an unknown timeframe, the garage door of the residence was struck by gunfire. No injuries or additional property damage were reported. No shell casings were located.

Commercial Burglary- On September 4, officers responded to a construction site located in the 11300 block of Braden Dr in Manassas (20109) to investigate a burglary. The investigation revealed sometime overnight, entry was made into an unsecured building and multiple tools and hardware were reported missing. No suspect information was available.

Malicious Wounding- On September 7 at 1:45AM, officers responded to Marumsco Plaza Shopping Center, located in the 13900 block of Richmond Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a fight. The investigation revealed the victim, a 19-year-old man, was involved in an argument with an unknown man, later identified as the accused. During the encounter the accused struck the victim, causing him to fall backwards and hit a curb. The victim sustained injuries and was transported to an area hospital for treatment. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Maged Rabie **GASEM**, was arrested.

Attempted Strong-Armed Robbery- On September 1, officers responded to the Salvation Army, located at 11201 Balls Ford Rd in Manassas (20109) to investigate an attempted robbery. The investigation revealed the victim, a Brinks Security employee, was in the process of retrieving money from the business when he was approached by an unknown man, later identified as the accused. During the encounter, the accused displayed a water gun and demanded money from the victim. The victim refused and the accused left the area. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Eladio Tomas **PUENTE MASON**, was arrested.
