Updates

Brandishing *ARREST- On September 7, the suspect sought in connection to the brandishing that was reported to have occurred at the Valvoline Instant Oil Change, located at 14103 Richmond Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) on August 21, was arrested. Officers located the accused, identified as David Michael **SIMS** and took him into custody without incident.

Brandishing [Previously Released]- On August 21 at 8:22PM, officers responded to the Valvoline Instant Oil Change, located at 14103 Richmond Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate brandishing. The investigation revealed an unknown man driving a gold minivan, pulled into the parking lot, exited the vehicle and brandished a firearm towards multiple employees, before leaving the area in the vehicle. No shots were fired and no injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a black male wearing a black graphic hoodie, black pants and black shoes.

Incidents

Residential Burglary- On September 9, officers responded to a residence located in the 17200 block of Larkin Ct in Dumfries (22026) to investigate a burglary. The investigation revealed sometime between September 7 at 9:00PM and September 8 at 9:00PM, the basement window was shattered, and entry was made into the residence. The house was rummaged through and jewelry was reported missing. No suspect information was available

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Incidents, *continued*

Commercial Burglary- On September 8, officers responded to the Urgent Medical Care Center, located at 17193 Wayside Dr in Dumfries (22026) to investigate a burglary. The investigation revealed between September 7 at 12:00PM and September 8 at 8:40AM, entry was made through an unlocked rear door, and an undisclosed amount of currency was reported missing. No suspect information was available.

Attempted Commercial Burglary- On September 8, officers responded to the Skrimp Shack, located at 17237 Wayside Dr in Dumfries (22026) to investigate an attempted burglary. The investigation revealed on September 8, between 1:55AM and 2:39AM, an unknown individual attempted to force open the front door to the business before leaving the area. Damage to the door was observed and no items were reported missing. The suspect was described as a Black individual, unknown gender, with short dark hair, wearing a dark colored hoodie, baggy pants and white shoes.

Arrests

Brandishing- On September 1, officers responded to investigate a brandishing that was reported to have occurred in the 8600 block of Parkland St in Manassas (20110) on August 31 at approximately 3:30PM. The investigation revealed the victim, an 18-year-old man, was walking in the area when he was approached by an acquaintance, later identified as the accused. During the encounter, the accused brandished a firearm and threatened the victim before leaving the area in a vehicle. No shots were fired and no injuries were reported. During the investigation, officers recovered multiple 3D printed firearm parts and ammunition from the accused residence. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as a **17-year-old male juvenile**, was arrested.
