Updates

Commercial Burglary *ADDITIONAL ARREST- On September 12, the suspect sought in connection with the burglary that was reported to have occurred at the Tobacco King, located at 14170 Minnieville Rd in Woodbridge (22193) on August 24, was arrested. Officer located the accused, identified as a **16-year-old male juvenile**, and took him into custody without incident.

Commercial Burglary [Previously Released]- On August 24 at 1:47AM, officers responded to Tobacco King, located at 14170 Minnieville Rd in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate an alarm activation. The investigation revealed five unknown men broke a window and entered into the business. The suspects took multiple vape products before leaving the area in vehicle that was determined to be stolen. A short time later, one of the suspects, later identified as the accused, was located by Dumfries Police and detained. Following the investigation the accused, identified as a 16-year-old male juvenile, was arrested. The investigation into the identity of the four additional suspects is ongoing

Commercial Burglary Investigations *ARREST- On September 11, the suspect sought in connection with a series of burglaries that were reported to have occurred on Larkin Ct and Wayside Dr in Dumfries (22026) between September 7 and September 8, was arrested. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Shanice Shentel **YATES**, was charged.

Residential Burglary [Previously Released]- On September 9, officers responded to a residence located in the 17200 block of Larkin Ct in Dumfries (22026) to investigate a burglary. The investigation revealed sometime between September 7 at 9:00PM and September 8 at 9:00PM, the basement window was shattered, and entry was made into the residence. The house was rummaged through and jewelry was reported missing. No suspect information was available.

Commercial Burglary [Previously Released]- On September 8, officers responded to the Urgent Medical Care Center, located at 17193 Wayside Dr in Dumfries (22026) to investigate a burglary. The investigation revealed between September 7 at 12:00PM and September 8 at 8:40AM, entry was made through an unlocked rear door, and an undisclosed amount of currency was reported missing. No suspect information was available.

Attempted Commercial Burglary [Previously Released]- On September 8, officers responded to the Skrimp Shack, located at 17237 Wayside Dr in Dumfries (22026) to investigate an attempted burglary. The investigation revealed on September 8, between 1:55AM and 2:39AM, an unknown individual attempted to force open the front door to the business before leaving the area. Damage to the door was observed and no items were reported missing. The suspect was described as a Black individual, unknown gender, with short dark hair, wearing a dark colored hoodie, baggy pants and white shoes.

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Incidents

Death Investigation- On September 13 at 4:19AM, officers responded to the 2700 block of Yosocomico Ln in Woodbridge (22191) to investigate a death. The investigation revealed officers located a deceased individual, identified as a 48-year-old man, inside his vehicle in a decomposed state. Preliminarily, there were no signs of foul play concerning the death. More information regarding the investigation will be released if deemed necessary.

Stabbing Investigation - On September 12, officers responded to investigate a stabbing that was reported to have occurred on Kerrydale Rd in Woodbridge (22191) at approximately 12:45AM. The investigation revealed the victim, a 16-year-old male juvenile, was walking to a family member's home when he was approached by three unknown men. During the encounter, the men assaulted the victim and stabbed him in the lower body and hand, before leaving the area. The victim was transported to an area hospital by a family member prior to officers' arrival and was treated for injuries that were later determined to be non-life threatening. The suspects were described as a black male and two Hispanic males wearing dark colored clothing and masks.

Aggravated Assault- On September 11, officers responded to investigate an assault that was reported to have occurred in the 13500 block of Richmond Hwy in Woodbridge (22191) at 10:32AM that morning. The investigation revealed the victim, a 39-year-old man, was walking in the area when he was almost struck by the driver of a white box truck. During the encounter, a verbal argument between the parties escalated and the suspect struck the victim in the upper body with a glass bottle, before leaving the area in the white box truck. The victim sustained injuries and was transported to an area hospital for treatment. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male, heavy set, wearing a white shirt.

Indecent Exposure- On September 11 at 8:30AM, officers responded to the 14300 block of Westminister Ln in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate an indecent exposure. The investigation revealed the victim, a 34-year-old woman, was walking her dog in the area when she observed an unknown man exposing himself and making obscene gestures. The victim was able to leave the area before reporting the incident to police. No physical contact occurred and no injuries were reported. The suspect was described as a black male wearing a black sweatshirt with the hood pulled up, black pants and black shoes.

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Arrests

Aggravated Malicious Wounding- On September 12 at 2:09AM, officers responded to the 7400 block of Willoughby Ln in Manassas (20109) to investigate a stabbing. The investigation revealed the victim, a 40-year-old man, and a family member, later identified as the accused, got into a verbal altercation that escalated. During the encounter, the accused stabbed the victim multiple times in the upper body, before leaving the scene in a vehicle. Arriving officers rendered aid to the victim, who was transported to an area hospital for treatment of injuries that were later determined to be non-life-threatening. Officers located the accused a short time later and he was taken into custody without incident. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Devon Christopher **FIELDS**, was arrested.
