Murder Investigation *ADDITIONAL ARREST- Prince William County detectives have charged an individual in connection with the shooting death of an 18-year-old Bristow man that occurred in the 7900 block of Community Dr in Manassas (20109) on June 25. On September 14, Prince William County detectives arrested the accused, identified as a **16-year-old male juvenile**, without incident.

Arrested on September 14: [Juvenile]

A **16-year-old male juvenile** of Manassas

Charged with **2nd degree murder** and **use of a firearm in commission of a felony**

Court date: **Pending** | Status: **Held at the Juvenile Detention Center**

Murder Investigation *ARREST [Previously Released]- Prince William County detectives have charged a man in connection to the shooting death of an 18-year-old Bristow man that occurred in the 7900 block of Community Dr in Manassas (20109) on June 25. On July 2, Prince William County detectives, with the assistance of the U.S. Marshal's Task Force and U.S. Marshal's D.C. Special Response Team, arrested the accused, identified as Jamal Dana **ALLEN**, at his home in Manassas. The investigation continues.

Homicide Investigation [Previously Released]- On June 25 at 8:47PM, officers responded to the 7900 block of Community Dr in Manassas (20109) to investigate what was initially reported as a crash. Arriving officers quickly located a vehicle that had crashed into an unoccupied, parked car. As officers approached the vehicle they located the victim, an 18-year-old man, in the driver's seat of the vehicle with a gunshot wound to the upper body. The man was pronounced dead on scene. The suspects left the area and were not immediately located. **Preliminarily, this incident does not appear to be random. Detectives are asking anyone with any information, or anyone who may have witnessed the incident, to contact police.** Additional information will be released when available. The investigation continues.

Commercial Burglary *ADDITIONAL ARREST- On September 14, the suspect sought in connection with the burglary that was reported to have occurred at the Tobacco King, located at 14170 Minnieville Rd in Woodbridge (22193) on August 24, was arrested. The accused, identified as a **17-year-old male juvenile**, turned himself into police and was taken into custody without incident.

Charged with **burglary, destruction of property, possession of a stolen vehicle, larceny with intent to sell, conspiring to trespass** and **curfew violation**

Commercial Burglary *ADDITIONAL ARREST [Previously Released]- On September 12, the suspect sought in connection with the burglary that was reported to have occurred at the Tobacco King, located at 14170 Minnieville Rd in Woodbridge (22193) on August 24, was arrested. Officer located the accused, identified as a **16-year-old male juvenile**, and took him into custody without incident.

Commercial Burglary [Previously Released]- On August 24 at 1:47AM, officers responded to Tobacco King, located at 14170 Minnieville Rd in Woodbridge (22193) to investigate an alarm activation. The investigation revealed five unknown men broke a window and entered into the business. The suspects took multiple vape products before leaving the area in vehicle that was determined to be stolen. A short time later, one of the suspects, later identified as the accused, was located by Dumfries Police and detained. Following the investigation the accused, identified as a 16-year-old male juvenile, was arrested. The investigation into the identity of the four additional suspects is ongoing

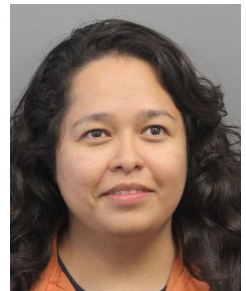

Incidents

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On September 14 at 4:37PM, officers responded to the 13600 block of Claytor Ln in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a report of shots fired. The investigation revealed an individual in a silver-gray sedan fired gunshots towards the victim, a 33-year-old man, who was seated in his vehicle, before leaving the area. Multiple gunshots struck the victim's vehicle and officers located shell casings in the area. During the investigation, the victim became uncooperative with officers. No injuries or additional property damage were reported.

Arrests

Reckless Handling of a Firearm- On September 14 at 1:40AM, officers responded to the 12600 block of Harbor Dr in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a call for shots fired. The investigation revealed the victim, a 36-year-old male, got into a verbal altercation with an acquaintance, identified as the accused. During the encounter, the dispute escalated and the accused brandished a firearm and fired a gunshot, striking the victim's vehicle. Officers arrived on scene and detained the accused, who was determined to be intoxicated. No injuries were reported. Following the investigation, the accused, identified as Katherine Lizeth **URRACO GARCIA**, was arrested.
