## **K-9 Gunner Dog Park**

## **Dog Park Rules**

- 1. Dog Park is for the use of dogs and handlers only.
- 2. Dog must be on leash when entering and exiting Dog Park.
- 3. Handlers must be in the Dog Park area with dog, have leash in hand and have voice control over their dog.
- 4. Handler limited to a maximum of 2 dogs.
- 5. All dogs must have current license, rabies and all other vaccinations, wear visible license and rabies tags.
- 6. No choke prong or spike collars
- 7. No female dogs in hear, not dogs under 4 months olds
- 8. Nor aggressive dogs allowed. At first sign of aggression, the aggressive dog must be leashed and immediately removed from the Dog Park by handler.
- 9. No Food. No glass containers.
- 10. Handler must "scoop the poop" and fill any holes dug by their dog.
- 11. Children 8 yrs. and under not permitted in Dog Park; children under the age of 16 yrs. must be accompanied by adult handler.
- 12. Use of facility is at own risk. By entering the dog park you agree not to hold liable Prince William County Dogs, Prince William County Parks & Recreation, or LRPRA for any injury or damage caused by any dog or handler in the Dog Park, or adjacent parking area.
- 13. Handlers are responsible for any injuries caused by the dog(s) under their control.
- 14. Failure to abide by the Dog Park Rules may result in loss of privileges and/or possible ticketing by appropriate authorities.
