Do your part to keep your home and belongings safe:

- Lock all entrances to your home, including garage entry doors, and close overhead garage doors at night. Open and unlocked doors provide quick and easy access to cars, items in garages, and homes.
- Lock vehicles even when parked in the garage.
- Lock all vehicles left in driveways or on the street overnight. Thieves can use garage door openers found in unlocked cars to access garages and homes.
- Do not leave valuables such as purses, wallets, keys, electronics, and <u>firearms</u> in cars parked in driveways or garages overnight. Consider tucking them away inside your home, rather than leaving them by the door.
