Household Hazardous Waste & Electronics Recycling Program

Certain hazardous materials (described below) may pose a risk to human health or the environment if placed in the regular trash. Prince William County provides special locations where these items may be dropped off for recycling and/or special handling. In addition to certain hazardous materials, County residents may also drop-off electronic equipment (computers, televisions, cell phones, etc.) at the locations below for recycling. This service is available to County residents only. Businesses and residents of the cities of Manassas and Manassas Park cannot use this program.

LIMIT PER VISIT

HHW items: 15 gallons or 40 lbs.

Electronics: 3 items

Electronics Accepted:

- Cell phones
- Computers, monitors, keyboards, etc.
- DVD players
- Printers
- Fax machines
- Radios/stereo equipment
- Televisions
- VCRs
- Other electronic equipment with an electric cord or circuit board

All items should be in the original labeled container whenever possible and should be sealed and packaged for safe transport. Used motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze, auto batteries, and household batteries are accepted during regular business hours in the citizens' drop-off/recycling area. **ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED**: include explosives, ammunition, medical waste, biological waste, asbestos, radioactive waste or unknown substances, and business generated hazardous and electronic waste. Call the Solid Waste Division for assistance in properly managing items not accepted by the program.
