






## **General Transportation Information**

- Project is part of VDOT's STARS program
  - Broader effort to increase capacity and safety along University Boulevard.
- STARS Report identifies 4 intersections along Prince William Parkway (Route 234 Bypass):
  - Sudley Manor Drive
  - Wellington Road
  - University Boulevard
  - Clover Hill





## **Project Overview**

- The Project is being administered by Prince William County Department of Transportation.
- The Project is a County project funded by the Northern Virginia Transportation Authority (NVTA) as part of the FY2018-2023 Six Year Program.
- Current budget is approximately \$24.2 million.
- Project limits Along Prince William Parkway:
  - From: Approximately 1,200 feet east of the existing Wellington Road Intersection
  - To: Approximately 1,500 feet east of existing University Boulevard Intersection
- Project limits Along Prince William Parkway:
  - From: Approximately 500 feet west of the existing Innovation Drive intersection
  - To: The eastern Leg of existing Hornbaker Road Intersection







## **Proposed Concept**








## **Traffic Operations**

- The new intersection improves overall traffic operations by removing left turns at the Prince William Parkway and University Boulevard intersection.
- Operationally, there are some similarities with cloverleaf interchange design where motorists travel slightly further but encounter lower overall delays.
- Safety is enhanced because there are fewer conflict points.




## **Traffic Operations**

Travel route for northbound left turn traffic.




Travel route for southbound left/right turn traffic.






## **Traffic Operations**

Travel route for eastbound left turn traffic.




Travel route for westbound left turn traffic.

# New Discovery Boulevard (Extension of Discovery Boulevard to Prince William Parkway) (N.T.S.)



- 4-lane divided roadway
- 16-foot grass median

- 10-foot shared use path
- 5-foot sidewalk





# Additional Design Features & Considerations

- Design speed of 35 mph New Discovery Boulevard;
- Two new traffic signals on New Discovery Boulevard; one at the intersection with Prince William Parkway and another at the intersection with University Boulevard
- Pedestrian and bicycle facilities along New Discovery Boulevard include:
  - 10-foot asphalt shared use path
  - 5-foot concrete sidewalk
- Project involves the improvements to two (2) additional intersections.
- Utility relocations are anticipated.
- The Project will improve overall traffic operations and safety.





## Right of Way Acquisition

- Some right of way, including temporary and permanent easements, will be required for construction.
- No anticipated residential displacements or relocations.
- No anticipated displacement of commercial properties.
- This project will involve a change and/or break in limited access control which requires CTB approval.
- Affected property owners will be contacted during the land acquisition process which is anticipated to start in the winter of 2020.


